Most college scholarships celebrate high achievers in academics, athletics, and the performing arts. But what about celebrating those great kids who positively affect the lives of others?

Taking a cue from Minnesota Masonic Charities, the members of Red Wing Masonic Lodge are proud to announce a unique education scholarship that is open to students in Red Wing.

The Red Wing Masonic Lodge Selfless-Scholar Scholarship's purpose is to encourage peer recognition of unexpected, purposeful, even life-changing acts of kindness.

Nominees should be those who make others feel like they are important and matter, not just in school but also in the community. The scholarship offers a tangible reward for being an extraordinarily good person, while also providing a scholarship to help that student continue their educational pursuits. What makes this scholarship very different from others is that you cannot seek it yourself: you must be nominated to be considered.

To nominate someone, you believe should be recognized for making others feel like they are important and matter:

1. Submit a short-essay (500-word maximum) explaining how the person has demonstrated extraordinary kindness, brought people together, or made someone feel like they matter.
