The Guilford County Council of PTAs awards the Judy Groves Elementary School Membership Award, the John R. Kernodle, Jr. Middle School Membership Award and the Melvin C. Swann, Jr. High School Award to the schools at each level who achieved the highest percentage increase in total memberships over the previous year in relation to their student enrollment. The awards are designed to challenge all Guilford County Schools to actively seek the support of their parents, teachers, staff and community. Please use the mathematical formula below to calculate your numbers. Your School Principal can provide you with your exact enrollment figure and your Membership Chair can provide the exact number of PTA members in your unit. Using this method, it is possible to have an increase in your overall membership from year to year, but if your school's enrollment varies, your percentages will be adjusted accordingly. Newly established PTAs will not be considered for this award.

EXAMPLE: Main Street Elementary had 234 PTA members and 339 students enrolled last school year. That means their percentage of PTA member to student was 69%. This year, Main Street Elementary had 422 Parents, Teachers, Grandparents and Community People to join their PTA serving 371 students. That brought their percentage of PTA members to students to 114%. By subtracting these two figures, they experienced an overall increase of +45!! Great job, Main Street Elementary PTA!!!!
