

Emergency Plan - continued

If the member refuses to leave after being instructed to do so, call local law enforcement by dialing 911 and have them escort the person from the grounds. Immediately after the event is over, file an incident report. Be thorough in your description of the situation and your response to it. Note any witnesses present and names of law enforcement personnel as appropriate. When the situation is under control, contact the CRSO, club president, club vice-president and inform them of the incident.

Some Common Rule Infractions To Watch For

- Transporting of firearms cased/uncased from vehicle to bench or bench to vehicle while range is cold.
- Barrel sweeping while trying to chamber a pistol or remove a jammed case
- Barrel sweeping while loading/unloading firearms to/from vehicle
- Firearm handling while on a cold range as a result of using/adjusting optics
- Moving forward of the firing line while range is hot to pick up spent cases
- Attempted use of unapproved targets and/or target stands that are metal
