A MESSAGE FROM WALK #142 SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR:

Lynnie and I are so blessed to be serving together on walk 142, this has added new meaning to working together, preparing for the walk. It is very exciting time thinking about what God is planning for us in October. I was reminded of this on walk 141 were we saw the floodgates of heaven open up and the rain fell down, showering upon all of us a special message of his love and grace. God touched all of our lives that weekend, pilgrims, conference and support team alike. Each of us who serve on and Emmaus walk experienced something that God had prepared ahead of time for us.



But as I think about it, I can't help but remember that each of us arrive at the camp at different spots along our spiritual journey. I guess for me the best story that describes how I feel is that of Elijah on Mount Carmel. The story is found in I Kings 18:20 – 19:21. On top of the mountain, Elijah had one of those mountain top experiences that we all cherish.

God showed up, ignited his offering and the rains came. Many in the conference room will climb to the top of the mountain and through the events of the weekend they will be filled with God's love in a new and fresh way. But there are others of us that will be on the walk at a point in our lives where we need to be nurtured by God. Elijah, after he came down from the mountain he fell into a dark part of his life where we hear his cry of despair, "*I have had enough Lord, Let me die. I am no better than my ancestors.*" Jezebel, the queen had promised to track him down and kill him. But as he lay under a bush, an angel of the Lord came and fed him, to give him the nourishment he needed for the long journey ahead. He rested and was nourished by the hand of God. Some in the conference room will be there and need to feel God's presence and receive the nurturing that only God can provide. I know that some of God's angels will be present during the walk to bring the nourishment needed. Then as Elijah's story continues, he leaves the bush, walked forty days and nights to Mount Sinai and enters a cave. The next morning God and Elijah talk, and then God's presence passes by him as Elijah stands at the mouth of the cave. Elijah did not hear God's voice in the wind, the earthquake or the fire, but it was in the quite gentle sound that followed. I wonder, how many of us will be quiet enough during walk 142 to hear the sweet words of God speaking to us. Yes, I am very excited about the upcoming walk, waiting for God hands and love to touch all of our lives.





He knows that when I disobey my guilt is all that's left


It seems by now I would listen but still I want to doubt
