Later the next week, the team hosted the Kings Invitational at Landen Park. The team took 2nd place with Robbie Winkler leading the team with an 8th place finish.

The team kicked off October at the Kettering Fairmont Invitational where they took 3rd, just behind Hilliard Davidson and LaSalle, two teams that will content this postseason.
