



YOUR LANDSCAPE DURING DRY SPELLS

WHAT YOU MIGHT PHYSICALLY SEE:

Plant Material:

- Yellowing of Leaves
- Curling and Limp Leaves
- 20-50% leaf drop
- Thinning
- Stop growing and shorter bloom periods

Sod:

- Grey-Green appearance between watering
- Blades of grass appear to fold in.
- Irregular patches of brown spots
- Chinch bug activity increases



HEAT TRACKING:

Our recent rise in temperature and continued drying winds, combined with lack of precipitation has caused multiple area of drying, stressed turf, nearing the wilting point.

As temperatures heat up and the moisture levels are depleted the turf loses its ability to cool itself through evapotranspiration.

With frequent traffic such as golf carts or lawn mowers, heat tracking may occur. It is difficult to predict when heat tracking may occur, but in almost all cases the turf recovers when adequate moisture is applied along with time.
