There will be an auction sale at the school April 14, 2018 at 9:00 am. The auction will begin in the auditorium and will proceed as directed by Lutter & Associates. Interested people may bid on: doors, windows, cabinets, desks, lockers and many other items. Bidders will go room to room and hallways to bid. Lockers and emptied items may be removed the day of the sale. Fixed items such as windows, doors, flooring may not be removed until after graduation which is May 12th at 4PM. The school has set aside three days for the successful bidders to remove their auction items from the school premises: after graduation Saturday, May 12, Sunday May 13th and Monday May 14th. Buyers PLEASE make a plan to remove your items on one of the designated days. Sale items will be clearly marked for the auction and will be carefully logged and recorded to avoid confusion when items are removed. The following timeline for May is as follows:



- * Saturday, May 5 – Practice for Community Concert in the Auditorium
- * Sunday, May 6 – Community Concert in the Auditorium
- * Tuesday, May 8 – Last day of school with students
- * Saturday, May 12 – Graduation in the Greeno Building
- * Saturday, May 12 – Removal of items after graduation starting at 4 PM
- * Sunday & Monday, May 13 & 14, - Removal of items from the school – 8 AM to 8 PM
- * Tuesday, May 15- General Contractor to clear buildings for demolition
- * Wednesday, May 16 – Demolition to begin

Time is of the essence for the project this summer. Permanent power cannot be put into the middle/high school until the 1971, 1934, and the 1954 buildings are torn down and the excavation complete and foundations poured for the new building. The work for Phase II of the project is slated to be completed during the summer of 2019.

After the demolition this summer, there will be 1,000 bricks that will be for sale via free will donation. Each person will be limited to six bricks. More details, such as where to pay and where the bricks can be picked up will be released at a later date. Shad Storley, Superintendent
