Welcome back, Dance Me Families!

We are so excited to be starting out the dance year, we have missed being able to dance with you in person so much!

This newsletter contains important information about our reopening protocols, upcoming dates, and our hybrid/virtual class options.

COVID Protocols:

For our Fall 2020/2021 season we have decided that masks are to be worn at all times, including during dance class. Masks are highly recommended by the CDC to prevent the spread of COVID-19. We are aware NYS does not require this for sports and recreational activities that can maintain social distance. However, Dance Me would like to err on the side of caution for all students, staff, and families. We will require any student, parent, or sibling over the age of 2 will be asked to wear a mask while in the studio for any reason. We thank you in advance for following our studio rules.

Dancers in Baby Ballerina, Preschool, and Kindy classes will be permitted to have ONE parent wait in the lobby during class time. Please note that our lobbies are not huge. This means that if a Preschool or Kindy class is larger in size, parent social distancing may not be possible. If you are not comfortable with remaining at the studio during class, please notify the teacher and we will ensure your student is safe during class time. Please arrive a few minutes prior to the end of class to pick up your child. For dancers who are level Blue and up, students will be dropped off and the lobby will be closed to parents. Thank you for your understanding as we have capacity requirements to abide by.

Changing rooms are currently closed. We ask your dancer to please arrive in dress code, as bathrooms are not to be used as changing rooms. Please only bring one bag with the dance shoes needed for that day and a bottle of water. We will continue to have water for sale in Studio A.

Each studio will be **fully cleaned and sanitized** at the conclusion of classes for the day, including all hard surfaces, mats, doorknobs, bathrooms, floors, and communal spaces. Air purifiers will be switched on to run overnight as well. This is in addition to the cleaning in between each individual class.

We are using a new online software for our parent portal called Jackrabbit Dance. This is where you can make payments, receive important information from the studio, and get information about your child's classes. Please log in to your Jackrabbit account to assure that all the information is correct. You can also check what classes your child is registered for and who their teacher is.
