It has been brought to our attention that there have been many illegal plantings being done around our community. The maintenance of these plantings ultimately would become the responsibility of The Meadows. Some of these grow to enormous size and become very unmanageable for our staff. In an effort to offset future difficulties we will be searching out and removing certain plantings, including but not limited to the 'Norfolk Pine'. It appears that one of these may be growing outside the five foot perimeter area that you are responsible for, but in the vicinity of your home.

During the month of August we will be removing many of these plantings. This letter is to serve notice to you as to what you may see our men doing, and why they're doing so.

An example of a 'Norfolk Pine' can be seen growing along the railroad tracks wall, located behind Lot #xxxx. It is so enormous that it can be seen from inside the clubhouse by looking east.
