CATEGORIES

(E) Editorial Photography

A visual account of specific subjects and events, literally representing objective reality with minimal editing i.e. color enhancement, sharpening, resizing and cropping.

(F) Fine Art Photography

Created in accordance with the vision of the artist as photographer. All editing is accepted i.e. composites, filters or any alterations made to produce the vision.

DIVISIONS

- (Y) Youth: Anyone under 18 years old.
- **(AM) Amateur:** Anyone 18 years or older who is not a professional.

(PRO) Professional: Anyone who sells their photos for profit, publishes, teaches photography classes for reimbursement, or has done graduate work in photography.

SHOW RULES

- Each photographer may enter up to 3 works in a Category with a maximum of 3 works for the show. Work must be original, completed within the last 2 years, and not previously exhibited at KIFA.
- KIFA Guidelines for hanging will be strictly enforced. The guidelines can be found on the KIFA website, on the Gallery Exhibits page.
- Submissions cannot exceed 28" x 28" including the frame.
- All entries must remain on display through the end of the show with the exception of works sold to out-of-town buyers.

- Each photographer is limited to 1 "Not For Sale" piece. All other pieces must be for sale.
- KIFA reserves the right to reject submissions deemed unsuitable. KIFA reserves the right to change the Category when a photograph is entered in an inappropriate Category or in a Category with insufficient entries.
- KIFA is not responsible for loss or damage to works, but reasonable caution will be taken.
- KIFA will take 30% commission on all work sold during the show.
- All works not removed from the property become property of KIFA after 30 days.

ENTRY FEES

Members \$20 up to 3 images
NonMembers \$25 up to 3 images
Youth/College \$2/image up to 3 images

Due to space limitations in the galleries, it is advisable to enter as early as possible. Entries received after the limit is reached will be returned with entry fee to the photographer. All accepted fees are non-refundable.
