Luke reviewed, in detail, the scope of project

Consultant, Roger Sheehan, has overseen and directed project IPS Service from Rossford was chosen as best company to complete project based on our scope and needs with a subcontract made with Laibe Electric for all electrical work

Air conditioning includes AC installation in the sanctuary, hall, and kitchen 2 five-ton cooling units in attic

Condensing units outside on north side of building

Electrical work done by Laibe electric

Upgrade electric to be able handle new AC requirements
New panel in basement for sanctuary units
Use current panels for hall and kitchen

Install new can lights in sanctuary

Boiler system would be replaced with removal and disposal of old boiler system Large discount given by IPS to do in conjunction with AC

An anonymous donor has specifically made donation to be used for air conditioning

\*\$67,334= total amount needed to complete project (includes \$15,000 contingency fund that is not expected to be needed)




