



NEW Raised-bed Community Garden

Sanburnol Park is home to the new raised-bed community garden. Located in the south east corner of the park, these raised-beds make gardening easier for you to plant, maintain and harvest your crops. Open to Spring Lake Park residents, the 4'x8' garden beds are available to reserve now, on a first-come, first-serve basis. One garden plot per household can be reserved by mail or in person at the Recreation Department. Fee is only \$20.00.

- There will be access to water, however, the gardens will be situated to receive regular watering from the park irrigation system.
- Barrels for waste and organic materials will be provided to encourage a clean garden area.
- Mowed grass paths separate the garden beds.
- You may use granular fertilizers and insecticidal soap for pest control. No aerosol or hose end sprayer fertilizers/pesticides will be allowed.
- The gardens will be available for planting beginning May 15 and will close October 31 when all plant materials shall be removed.
- Garden hours are 5:00 am – 10:00 pm.
- Be a good gardener and harvest only your crops.
- These raised beds are a natural pest deterrent. However, temporary fencing will be allowed but must be removed at the end of the season.
