



Letter To The Right Honorable Prime Minister Trudeau:

I live in Calgary, Alberta and I am trying to help the thousands of people who suffer from cancer and all these terrible diseases that cause so much pain and take away from their ability to live comfortably. The only way I can help is to fully support your Medical Marijuana proposals. My background is in the financial industry in Canada, on the processing side of this industry. Since I am fully aware of the Banking Regulations surrounding Marijuana, I find that these regulations are a detriment to the individuals who really need this substance for medical purposes. I have developed a card that could be used in the Medical Marijuana community, it is called WEEDebit Inc.

which is registered federally across Canada and the website is [www.weedebit.com](http://www.weedebit.com). If the Government of Canada would de-criminalize Marijuana for medical use only, the banks could open merchant accounts for the many legal and registered growers and pharmacies in Canada. That would allow WEEDebit the ability to not only produce these cards for the medical Marijuana industry, but the card could also be an identifier for those who do have legal prescriptions and can go to pharmacies in order to fill their prescriptions. They would then be able to pay with the same card that has their complete medical information on it, including the Doctor who wrote the prescription. Since I am in the FI industry I understand the need for an audit trail, therefore using the WEEDebit Card would simplify the audit process for the banks and for Revenue Canada. I can only imagine the positive tax revenue that Canada would enjoy for infrastructure and social programs.

My hope is that you will consider my proposal to decriminalize the medical use of Marijuana and that you will accept the usage of my card product for the Medical Marijuana community throughout Canada. At this time the card is only used as a membership card in this industry.
