1. All classes must be registered animals except for steer and commercial classes.
2. Breeding Beef classes are judged by breed unless indicated as “all breeds competing.”.
3. Points Awarded as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> – 40 pts.; 2<sup>nd</sup> – 35 pts; 3<sup>rd</sup> – 30 pts.; 4<sup>th</sup> – 25 pts.; 5<sup>th</sup> – 20 pts.; and 6<sup>th</sup> – 15 pts. No Points are awarded for Grand Champion or Reserve Champion Awards.
