School of Medicine in New Orleans in 1994 and a fellowship in Diagnostic and Interventional Neuroradiology in 1996. She moved to Lafayette that year to join Acadiana Radiology Group. She is the current Medical Director of Radiology for Heart Hospital of Lafayette and is also a Clinical Associate Professor of Radiology at L.S.U. School of Medicine. Dr. Wojak is a Board Certified Radiologist since 1994. She has Subspecialty Certification in Neuroradiology, which she originally received in 1997; she completed her re-certification in 2007

She is recognized as a Fellow of the Society of Interventional Radiology (SIR) and Fellow of the American Heart Association (AHA) Stroke Council, and is a member of the SIR Standards Committee, SIR Foundation Quality Improvement Committee and American College of Radiology Standards Committee.

As a member of ARG, Dr. Wojak specializes in the treatment and practice of Cerebral and Body Angiography, Angioplasty, Uterine Fibroid Embolization, Biliary Drainage, Aneurysm Coiling, Nephrostomy, Stroke Treatment, and Vertebroplasty.
