

Sheep & Goat Exhibition Shows

Friday, August 30, 2019 – 4:30 p.m.

SHEEP/GOAT COSTUME CONTEST

This show is a fun-filled experience for exhibitors as well as spectators. Children ages six to eighteen can participate. **And, this year, we'll add an adult division.** Both the sheep or goat and the exhibitor should dress for the occasion. Exhibitor must choose whether to enter class with a goat or a lamb, but not both in same class. Review general rules of Open Livestock Show (Department B) for entries to follow. Exhibitors are required to show their sheep or goat with a halter. Participants in this contest with an animal that is not owned need to sign a waiver before participating. See coordinator for details. Each contestant must register for this show in the vegetable barn by 9 a.m. on Friday of Fair week. Exhibitors must write a narrative about their costumes and turn it in prior to the contest. There will be two sections in this show:

SECTION I – THEME: "Blue Ribbon Sights, Pullin' Nights, and Midway Lights"

This section will be judged on the costume that best depicts this year's fair theme. Create a short story about the costume you picked and how it relates to your animal, which will be read during the contest.

SECTION II – CONTESTANT'S CHOICE

Participants are encouraged to dress creatively. Create a short story about your costume that will be read during the contest.

PRIZES: 1st-\$10; 2nd-\$8; 3rd-\$5

PETS

All pet lambs and calves must be fed by owner during the class. Open to youth under the age of 10 years.

1. Pet Lamb, Ewe or Wether
2. Pet Goat, Doe or Wether
3. Bucket Calf (newborn to 400 lbs.)

PRIZES: 1st-\$10; 2nd-\$8; 3rd-\$5

YOUTH SHEEP/GOAT OBSTACLE COURSE SHOW

The obstacle course is a timed event that provides challenges for the exhibitor and excitement for the spectators. This show is open to all youth exhibitors ages 6-18 who exhibited sheep in the 4-H/FFA and/or open sheep show (other participants in this contest with an animal that is not owned need to sign a waiver before participating). Entries for this contest should be made by 9:00 a.m. on Friday of Fair week.

1. Junior Division (ages 6-8)
2. Intermediate Division (ages 9-12)
3. Senior Division (ages 13-18)
4. Goat entries (All ages)
