Town Board Meeting 6-14-21

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting of the Town of Eaton was called to order by Chairman Rick Christel at 6:30 p.m., Monday, June 14, 2021 at the Eaton Town Hall. The Pledge Allegiance to the flag was recited by all.

MEETING NOTICES: Meeting notices were posted at the Eaton Town Hall and the Town Website

ROLL CALL: Rick Christel, Chairman; Adam Schetter, Supervisor, Lewy Schema, Supervisor, Paulette Vogt, Clerk, Pam Schneider, Treasurer, Curt Green, Constable, and Craig Zipperer, Road Superintendent, were in attendance along with Randy Knier.

AGENDA: The agenda had been emailed previously. Supervisor Schema made a motion to accept the agenda, Supervisor Schetter 2nd the same, and motion carried.

MINUTES: The minutes from the May 14, 2021 board meeting had been emailed to the Board previously. Supervisor Schetter made a motion to accept the minutes, Supervisor Schema 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

PUBLIC INPUT: There was no public input so Chairman Christel closed public input.

ROAD SUPERINTENDENT: Superintendent Craig Zipperer reported on the many jobs he has been doing this month to include replacing a culvert on Murphy Lane, mowing ditches, and working on some down trees.

SUPERVISOR 1: No report

SUPERVISOR 2: No report

TREASURER' REPORT: Treasurer Pam Schneider reported \$230,528.04 was the ending balance for May in the Bank First Elite Account. She further reported that there is \$13,611.84 in the Bank First Checking Account. The Road Maintenance Account has a \$25,378.61 balance, the Road Equipment has a \$10,000 balance, the Dog Fund has a \$1,025.56 balance, and the checking account interest has a balance of \$367.65

Supervisor Schema made a motion to accept the treasurer's report and Supervisor Schetter 2nd the same. Motion carried.

CONSTABLE'S REPORT: Constable Green reported that he received a call about kittens but they were no at the resident's home when he arrived there.

ASSESSOR'S REPORT: No Report

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT:

Chairman Christel stated that he received a couple of calls inquiring if building permits were applied for at different residents. He stated he will check into this further.

Recycling Center: There was a discussion on the recycling center contract and will be tabled as Harter's Recycling representative could not attend our meeting at this time. We will put it on next month's agenda.

Marsh Road Damage: A discussion was held about the damage to Marsh Road by a resident of the Town hauling manure. The intersection at Marsh Road and Hickory Hills Road was damaged. Road Supervisor Zipperer said he would have to saw cut the damaged part and take it out with the tractor. He would replace it with a 200 foot wedge and then chip seal that. Road Supervisor will get prices for this work. This was then tabled for next month's agenda.

Recycling Center paving: Road Supervisor Zipperer reported that the County would pave the entrance area to the recycling center (70 feet x 30 feet) for a cost of \$3,164.00. This would entail using 237 square yards of material. A motion was made by Supervisor Shetter to have the Manitowoc County Highway Department do the work for the entrance to the recycling center for \$3,164.00. Supervisor Schema 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Broad Band: Chairman Christel received information about different internet systems in the area. After some discussion, the Board is going to look into this and put it on next month's agenda.

Approve Vouchers: April Vouchers were paid with a motion from Supervisor Schema and a 2nd from Supervisor Schetter in the amount of \$14,822.01. Motion carried.

MEETING REPORTS: Chairman Christel read a WTA Manitowoc County Unit Meeting Agenda for the next meeting to be held at the Good Times in Mishicot on June 17, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.

MISCELLANEOUS: Chairman Christel stated that the garbage stickers are now done.

CLERKS REPORT: Clerk Vogt stated she had received an email from the County Treasurer that the Dog Licenses and Tax Program will be going live on the website starting in 2022. Clerk Vogt further stated that she had applied for the 2021 Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds and received confirmation that they had received it. The amount of money designated for the Town of Eaton from the American Rescue Plan Act is \$86,246.89. The town will be waiting word from the United States Treasury to see what this money can be spent on in the Town.

With no further business to report, Supervisor Schema made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor Schetter 2nd the same. Motion carried.
