Remembering Beth Andries

Editor's note: Longtime model horse hobbyist Beth Andries passed away on May 16 after having lost her battle with cancer. She was 51.

Last fall, Beth and her good friend Alicia Vogel teamed up to donate 39 beautifully organized binders of Beth's collection of 1984-2008 model horse magazines and newsletters (pictured below with our pupster Sachi) to our Model Animal Hobby History Archive, part of the VCMEC Museum. We're deeply grateful for this historic gift!

Alicia has written a beautiful tribute to Beth, and it begins in the next column. But first, here's what Beth wrote about herself on her AOL member page in '99:

"I'm a Texan (hmm, go figure!), was born near Houston and moved to Austin in the early '80s. How do I feel about Texas? I luv it, luv it, luv it!

"I'm 28, a bit tall (5'10"), have a cat and over 150 horse figurines. Yes, I know I'm nuts.

"I love critters, as long as they're not spiders. I'll handle any living creature as long as I know it can't hurt me (okay I know some spiders, i.e. tarantulas, can be 'tame' but I'm not gonna hold the buggers!).

"I graduated from the University of Texas at Austin in 1992 with a degree in English and Psychology. Don't worry, I won't try to correct your spelling and grammar or try to pick your mind:). U.T. was a wonderful experience and I made sure to have a VERY varied curriculum. For example, I took a class on Mayan hieroglyphs!

"I love football. The University of Texas Longhorns and Washington Redskins are my favorite teams.

"I love to fish for trout and redfish on the Texas coast too. My favorite spot is in Rockport, TX. It's a neat 'resort'-type town, not too big and not too small.

My '9-5' job is working as a medical secretary in the surgery department of a major trauma hospital here in Austin. Yes, it is a lot like the show 'E.R.' at times.

I work in my off hours as a chauffeur (or 'chauffeuse') for Sedans, Inc. I really love to drive and meet people so this job is perfect!;)

Okay, 'nuff about me, let's look at horsies! Here's one of my favorite model horses, the #88 Overo Paint by Breyer. I have several variations of this fellow, I think he's really purty!;)



My favorite memory of Beth Andries is back around the time we first moved to Austin. My husband and I were walking home from the movie theater that was across from our apartment. A white stretch limo pulled up into the parking lot and slowed down in front of us. Beth popped out in her driver uniform and we did the standard girl squeal of greeting. She gave me a big hug. My husband did not know what the heck was going on, but after that I think she was his favorite hobby friend.

I knew Beth through the model horse show scene here in Texas, and the Austin Stampede model horse shows she ran in the late '90s. She loved draft horses (her draft Stone collection was the one to beat in the late '90s) and gaited horses. But she was interested in everything original finish: Breyer, Hartland, and Hagen-Renaker. She was always positive, and never had a bad word to say about anybody. She went to a show to have fun... okay, and maybe win a bit.

It was many years later that I got to know

her more outside the hobby. Eight years after she had moved to Las Vegas (after her divorce from her husband/limo service business partner), she went back to Austin. In the meantime she had a storage unit where she stashed all of her belongings at the time of her divorce. What I didn't know was how

much of a rush it was. She literally grabbed everything she had and threw it in there. Beth asked for help in excavating it, and I volunteered.

It was a wild time capsule, with a lot of laughing and screaming at discoveries like half-filled shampoo bottles, floppy disks, and a basket of Blackberry phones.

Her model horse collection was in there as well, individually packed by movers in ziplock bags and wrapped in toilet paper. Sometimes stuffed in lots in the same bag. I watched as she was reunited with her gems, and recoiled with her whenever there was a casualty.

It was about two days of hobby archeo-



logy, swapping stories, and mystification at some of the early twenty-first century artifacts. The photo above was taken during it. I got a sense of her love of horses that started in her childhood, and her love of the hobby. She had also gathered a wealth of material of hobby literature. She was interested in everything, and must have turned over every leaf to get the full bookshelf's worth of books, magazines, booklets, and fanzines from the hobby's infancy.

It wasn't until later the second day that she said she was battling cancer.

When she moved back to Las Vegas, we spent those years swapping silly texts. Later she sent support when my husband got diagnosed with lymphoma. It was a surprise a week before she passed, she texted me and indicated that things had gone south and we

talked about her collections' future.

Our last text:

Me: stay in touch ok?

Beth: Absolutely

Beth was a good friend to me, and a great friend of the hobby. I miss her.

At press time comes word that Beth's family has started an annual fundraiser in memory of Beth and her lifelong love of animals. Proceeds will benefit PAWS of Austin. 

Find Out More with Ephemera

Paper show photos? Paper pedigrees? In this digital age, some might be tempted to toss those pesky papers that a vintage custom may have accumulated along the way. But this ephemera, getting scarcer as time goes on, is an important resource now to learn more about these oldsters.

Intended to be mailed in to any of the many model horse photo shows of the time, paper show photos include a wealth of information the horse's then-owner recorded on the photo back: The horse's name, the year the horse was "foaled" (not the year the horse was created, as some today mistakenly assume), the horse's color, breed, and gender, the owner's name and address, and sometimes the names of the customizing artist and photographer.

An extra-valuable feature was added by some photo labs when printing the photo: the actual month and year the photo was printed. The photo lab's date has helped any number of undated vintage customs, nailing down a year in which the horse existed.

Pedigrees and Sire & Dam lists may also have info on a horse's identity and history. Hobby publications from the time may also hold clues, especially in their ads.

When it comes to the quest for info on our vintage customs, ephemera is the ultimate resource. So don't pitch those pesky papers!

The richness and luminescence of the palomino color on him is extraordinary --he glows but never becomes garish; he has so much bloom, but never looks like 'carnival paint.' And the tone is so luscious and deep, too, it's just such a standout among all the palominos l've seen. And I just love the way his mane was painted! Just a phenomenal balance of qualities make Matar a real stand-out for me."

MIKHAIL (SSt)

Arabian stallion ~ CM by Kay Holmes

in the 1970s

Sarah writes, "The degree of finesse and quality of this extensively redone SM Arab Stallion is mind-blowing, especially considering his scale and that he was done in the '70s when materials and methods were still so experimental and developing. He looks like he was made during the '80s, even the '90s! Stablemate remaking is extremely difficult to do well due to the scale, and so they tend to have workmanship flaws in anatomy, scale, and overall refinement. Not this guy. This guy has articulations that are well done and he's retained his refinement, especially through the legs, and his workmanship--despite the photo flash--I can tell is very skilled and thoughtful. And a thread mane and tail?! On a Stablemate? Done this well?! Wow. Just wow! And he's got personality to spare, not an easy thing to do on that scale. This artist nailed it with this piece, creating a tour de force Stablemate remake!"

Morgan stallion ~ CM by Laura Hornick Behning in the 1970s

And he was done in the '70s?! This piece is simply an anachronism, he's so far ahead of his time artistically. Indeed, he could be put into the highly competitive workmanship classes today and do quite well. That's a genius at work, pouring a lot of thought and love into a piece, and it's wonderful to see."

Sarah writes, "This enchanting little foal isn't only technically superbly done and loaded with presence, but I really appreciate the boldness of the color choice. A risk was taken here and it was pulled off exceptionally well, and if there are two things I greatly value in a piece, it's a risk well taken and well executed. Just a great piece."

Sarah writes, "I am absolutely fascinated by this piece! The degree of work on her is nuts--whoever the artist was had enough ambition and boldness for five artists! It's wonderful! This artist put a tremendous amount of care into her, and it shows through her refinement, smooth paint job, nice expression, nice hair jobjust an all 'round pretty well done piece despite it all. Here we see this piece pure in her history, and it's such a beautiful, rare thing. Thank you."

As such, he's a benchmark piece in our history I think, a moment in time where the stars aligned to produce something that

helped not just to define an entire decade, but to also be a part of propelling it forwards into the '80s."





And I so love it when artists go sideways with a common mold! Just a little imagination and vision can do amazing things!"

Grade Shetland gelding ~ CM by Chris Lapp (Flint) in 1992

Sarah writes, "Again, we have another brilliant body swap, this time a Merrylegs with a Swaps head. Look at the result! Holy cow, that's cool! And his workmanship is exemplary, but that's typical of this artist's work. A Golden Cross: Innovation + vision + talent = amazing things!"

Sarah writes, "What?! A Classic Quarter Horse Foal! That's crazy nuts! And look at the typey ASB filly that resulted! My gosh, my head is spinning from all the awesome, and at all the work that entailed!"


OVERALL IMPRESSIONS:

Ardith Carlton writes, "In 1986, Liz Bouras came to visit and brought along a new acquisition that she'd finally scored after wanting him for years: Kandu Koho.

"At that point I'd been showing for a year and knew Nancy Strowger's paintwork was considered the pinnacle, but hadn't yet seen any of her work in person. One look at Koho and I was instantly wowed--had never seen such a rich chestnut! I was such a pup, I hadn't yet heard of the collaborating artist who had done Koho's remaking, Beth Peart, but Liz quickly filled me in on how outstanding, and scarce, Beth's work was.

"I never, ever forgot Koho, and 26 years later, when Liz was downsizing, I asked if he and another favorite, Wickenden Osprey, might be available. It turned out both were in need of some restoration, which I was certainly willing to have done! So Liz kindly parted with the pair, Meghann Hoscheid did a fantastic job restoring them for me, and both then journeyed to Japan, where they ruled me and Corky's living room in an over-

head case all their own for several years, before we all came back home to the U.S. in 2019. (Koho's show photo was shot while in Japan, with the wooded foothills of Tochigi Prefecture's Mt. Mikamo behind him.)

"I'm so honored to be the caretaker for Kandu Koho, and for his longtime (since 1986... that's 35 years and counting!) barnmate Wickenden Osprey, too--as fine a pair of foxy grandpas as they come!"



BROOKRIDGE DANTON

Quarter Pony stallion ~ CM by Laura Behning in the late 1970s

Gee, kinda miss him even tho' I know that sounds kind of silly--I just get attached to my model horses. *SIGH*' Not silly at all, Kay. I think we all do.

"While he isn't dated (nor signed), I believe he was created in 1979 going off my memory of what she told me when I got him. She mentions in the letter that she showed him only once before I bought him off her, and that was at the Southwestern Ohio Classic in 1981 where he did well for her.

"I still think he's one of the coolest little dudes in my collection."

Laura Doll writes, ""Although I started photo showing in the '70s, it wasn't until 1988 that I attended my first live model horse show. I had graduated college that spring and was taking a year off before graduate school. So that summer I loaded up my car in Louisville, Kentucky, and headed off for Ozark Mountain Live in Springfield, Missouri, which was part of the Heart of America Live Show Circuit, I had exchanged letters with a few of the people associated with the show, but I basically arrived nervous and knowing no one. It was at that show that I met Chris Flint (Chris Cook at the time). She took me under her wing and was so helpful and kind, and we became fast friends.

"After that first one, I was hooked on live

shows and decided that I wanted to go Kathleen Maestas' 'Model Horse World' show in Nevada that fall. Chris wasn't interested in showing there, but said she would come along to sell models, plus bring her tack and props to help me show. (Nothing better than a 3-week roadtrip with someone you have known for maybe 2 days! Thankfully, we had a great time and are friends to this day.) When I arrived at her house in Overland Park, Kansas, to begin our adventure she had an amazing array of models that she had painted to sell out west. I bought a few immediately, of course!

"She was still finishing up some horses and the one we referred to as 'Sparky' was one of those. I kept telling myself I didn't need to buy any more, but there he was on her stovetop with his paint drying, calling out to me! As we worked on models at her kitchen table those next few days, I kept looking at him until I finally gave in--Sparky had to be mine! I've never regretted buying him--I still adore him. At the time, I thought he needed a more formal show name and Chris suggested Spartacus based on his nickname. It suits him well!""

Amour was consigned to the 1989 MARA-ABC Select Sale by Adren King, who noted she was 'a rich, dappled mahogany bay color with subtle amber shadings, a bit different than past black-bays by J. Ross.' She sold as a daughter of Adren's stallion Aragonce. I already adored Jason's work and even in a black-and-white xeroxed photo she was clearly something special. But I did not get her in the sale--I believe someone snatched her up at her Direct Sale buy-it-now price. I confess I don't recall

how she came up for sale after that, but this was not a love I would let slip through my fingers twice! I love her rich color, her exquisite face and her overall demeanor of calm and grace.

"I'm really racking my brain for how I came to own her. My notes on the sale catalog identify the three horses I bought, and there's a line through her name and that of another mare I fancied, so I believe they were both gone. I know I had her by 1994 at the latest. (I am also REALLY wishing I could find the first lot in this sale, a dark dapple grey Strowger Terrang who would look so very lovely with my light dapple grey Ross Terrang...)."

Since I had always ridden American Saddlebreds, I thought that a pleasure ASB would be the perfect versatility horse. I told Chris what I was looking for and she created Personal Effects. She is exactly what I was hoping for. She could show in Saddleseat, English, Western, Trail, Harness, and Parade classes. So much fun to show! (And so many tack changes--yikes!)

"Her bright chestnut color and markings are based on a pleasure Saddlebred that I rode in lessons in high school. (She was the closest I ever came to having a horse of my own--until my dad figured out how expensive it would be to own a horse--haha!) Her name 'Personal Effects' came from the lyrics of a song by my favorite local band at the time. She is in great shape for her age and is displayed in a place of honor on my shelves."


