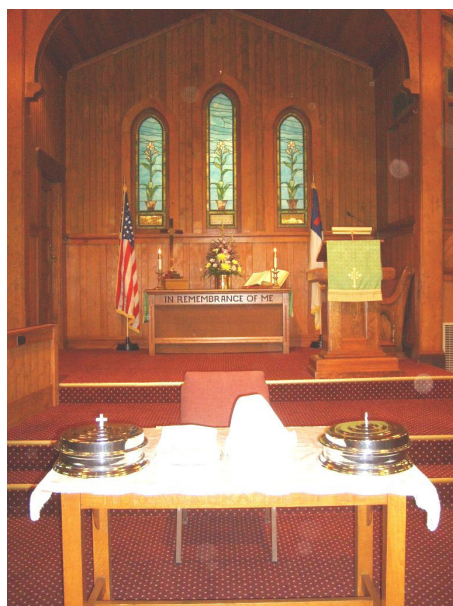


What's happening at church these days?
