**1st Reading Wis 7:7-11
[Riches of Wisdom]**

Figuratively, the author puts these words into the mouth of King Solomon. The king had asked for wisdom, which in Biblical language is not only learning but practical skill and insight as well. Actually, such wisdom stands for a good philosophy of life, which is worth more than health or comeliness, if one does not know how to live with either one prudently. The rich young man of the Gospel narrative did not understand this.

(Responsorial Psalm).

God's word to us insist on a decision. By their life-styles Christians should witness to real value that lead to happiness— in Biblical terms, values that witness to the kingdom of God as initiated already here on earth.

Twenty-Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Saddest Story in the Gospel (Mark 10:17-22)

- "Good Teacher: what must I do to inherit everlasting life?"
- "You know the commandments."
- "All these I have observed from my youth."
- "Jesus looking upon him loved him, 'You lack one thing: go, sell what you have, and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow me.'"
- "At this saying his countenance fell, and he went away sorrowful."

Theme: Renunciation and Stewardship

A song from the musical *Godspell* has these lines concerning Jesus of Nazareth: "See [know] him more clearly, love him more dearly, follow him more nearly." Millions have done so over the centuries and countless others are still doing so today; and all have found the key to a meaningful life. In the Catholic tradition we know of two life-styles in which Christians search for meaning and happiness.

One of them is marriage, which is the life-style of most people. Facing life together, they try to see the Lord Jesus more clearly, love him more dearly, and follow him more nearly through the good stewardship of all the beauty and goodness of life that God has bestowed upon them. The other life-style, for those who are called to it, is "celibacy for the sake of the kingdom." It is a life of renunciation not as an end in itself but for a life of discipleship.

If they are well understood, both life-styles should witness to the same Christian mystery, namely, God's kingdom of justice, love and peace as already initiated in human history. Today's Scripture readings deal with the issue of life-style.
