

MASS READING RELFECTION

Oct 14, 2018

1st Reading Wis 7:7-11 [Riches of Wisdom]

Figuratively, the author puts these words into the mouth of King Solomon. The king had asked for wisdom, which in Biblical language is not only learning but practical skill and insight as well. Actually, such wisdom stands for a good philosophy of life, which is worth more than health or comeliness, if one does not know how to live with either one prudently. The rich young man of the Gospel narrative did not understand this.

Wisdom is a gift of God for which we should pray: "Teach us to number our days aright, that we may gain wisdom of heart"

(Responsorial Psalm).

Reading Heb 4:12-13 [God's Living Word]

God's word to us insist on a decision. By their life-styles Christians should witness to real value that lead to happiness– in Biblical terms, values that witness to the kingdom of God as initiated already here on earth.

Whether married or celibate for the sake of God's kingdom, our way of life should be marked by that allpenetrating word of God. Someday we must render an account!

which Christians search for meaning and happiness. One of them is marriage, which is the life-style of most people.
