2. Review/ Approve meeting minutes

A motion was made by Mr. McNeil and Selectmen voted 3-0 to approve February 16, 2016 meeting minutes and warrant.

3. New Business

Insurance Policy -

Received policy from Scott Lovejoy and Selectmen reviewed. Schedule a meeting with Scott Lovejoy to discuss policy. Does Ingalls Pond and Sand Pond get covered? Is there a blanket policy?

- **FE Wood Meeting** Selectmen reviewed and accepted 3-0 the FE Wood meeting minutes that took place on February 25th.
- <u>School project out to bid again?</u> Selectmen approved to put out the school project back out to bid.
 This includes the ADA bathroom work and insulation.
- Award Maietta project to TRC TRC was the only firm to bid on the Maietta CUP review project. \$19,500 would pay out of contingency to TRC. Maietta is \$20,000 behind on their taxes claiming no personal property. Currently there are 6 conveyers, crusher and storage trailers on the Maietta property. Pictures were taken and will be sent to the Town attorney. Maietta has until April 1st to pay taxes in full. If not, the town will own the property. If they pay the taxes, a quit-claim deed wll be processed to Maietta for the property.

4. Old Business

Boston Cane Policy

Selectmen reviewed and approved 3-0. the Boston Cane Policy as drafted. The policy states that the original cane will be kept in the historical society and a replica will be given to the recipients. One replica is to get rotated around to the oldest resident. There is a pin that resembles the Boston Cane that will be given to the recipient to keep.

Calderwood Engineering

Dearborn Road Bridge culvert project will be put out to bid. Will also be applying for the culvert grant. The grant will reimburse any funds that are spent on the project. Will notify local contractors, coordinate with Calderwood and post in the local shopping guide after town meeting.
