- The Police Department has sent out several letters to residents concerning nuisance violations on their property including tall grass/weeds and inoperable automobiles. Most properties have been brought into compliance.

Water & Sewer/Streets & Alley Report - Marc Lemrise

- Hydrant flushing and pothole patching has been going on around town.
- Two valves will need to be repaired soon.
- The water main that runs under Rt 251 on the south edge of town needs to be updated in the near future. There has been a serious leak the last

three winters.

Engineer's Report - Jack Kusek

- A motion was made by Todd Anderson and 2nd by Bob Anderson for a pay request made by Vissering Construction in the amount of \$153,263.97 and McClure Engineering in the amount of \$5,122.39 for the new water treatment plant.
- Finishing up road paving at the water treatment plant in early October.
 Fencing and landscaping is currently being done. Everything should be completed by the next board meeting.
- A motion was made by Bob Folty and 2nd by Dave Wiesbrock to take out the no parking signs on the south side of Pontiac St and replace the no parking signs on the north side of Pontiac St.

Attorney's Report - Robert Steele

 A motion to pass Ordinance #602 Appropriations Ord after a few changes was made by Tom Goskusky and 2nd by Bob Anderson. A copy of the ordinance is available at the village hall.

Trustees Comments & Complaints

- A motion was made by Todd Anderson and 2nd by Dave Wiesbrock to replace a tree at the park that was damaged and needed to be cut down due to storms.
- A washout next to the church needs to be fixed along with a washout next to a walkway bridge on Oneca St.
- A motion was made by Todd Anderson and 2nd by Bob Folty to donate \$100 to the Tonica Grade School PTC for the Oktoberfest fundraiser and \$50 to the American Red Cross.
