

The 1980 annual is dedicated this year to a woman who has taught us much, and who continues to teach us even tho she is no longer in Magdalena.

She is now fighting a battle that may go on for the rest of her life. We must not let her fight alone.

Barbara was thrown from her horse in the spring of 1980 while riding after school in the foothills. She was discovered some time later by the Magdalena Search and Rescue Team, and was rushed to the hospital in Albuquerque suffering severe head injuries.

She was not expected to live.


After extensive brain surgery, which she survived, she was not expected to fully recover.

Barbara is now out of the hospital and on the road to a full recovery. But it isn't easy.

We all know Barbara as a dedicated, hard working, optimistic person who refuses to give up or to be beaten. While coaching in Magdalena, she molded a group of girls who won very few games, into a competetive volleyball team. Despite numerous setbacks and a general lack of support, she kept on pushing. She worked tirelessly with both the track team and the junior high girls basketball team.

She brings that same dedication, hope and hard work to her fight to fully recover from her devastating injuries. But she needs her friends to help.

It is only right that we should try and give back a little to one who has taught us so much about life and about living.

Initiation has been going on a long time in Magdalena, as far back as anyone can remember, and old traditions die hard.




























































## BOXING IS A BIG HIT IN MAGDALENA



Several of MHS's young men are doing their fighting in the ring, after school and in competition across the state.


