OFFICIAL MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF WESTON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, WESTON COUNTY, WYOMING October 17, 2023

The regular meeting of the Weston County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Ed Wagoner at 9:00 a.m. at the Weston County Courthouse. Commissioners Nathan Todd, Don Taylor, Vera Huber and Garrett Borton, and Clerk Becky Hadlock were present. Commissioner Huber led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Chairman Wagoner asked to add Update on Consensus Spending under Old Business and Commissioner Borton asked to add Rocks in Indoor Arena under Old Business. Vice-Chairman Todd moved to approve the agenda as amended; seconded by Commissioner Taylor. Carried.

Commissioner Taylor moved to approve the Consent Agenda which included the Minutes of October 3, 2023, Treasurer's Report, Chairman's Signature on Rental Agreement – Weston County Annex – Stulken Law Office, Chairman's Signature on Resolution 2023-27 – Open Burning Restrictions Lifted, Chairman's Signature on Resolution 2023-28 – Amendment to the 2023-28 – Amendment to the 2023-24 Budget, Tax Roll Correction #1607; seconded by Commissioner Borton. Carried.

Commissioner Huber moved to allow the Courthouse and Annex to close at 11:30 a.m. on November 17th for Critical Incident Response Training for staff; seconded by Commissioner Borton. Carried.

Sheriff Bryan Colvard brought a \$10,277.20 proposal from Aegix Global LLC for a response system for the County buildings. Discussion ensued. This will be added under Old Business for the next meeting.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING E-911 TAXES TO BE REROUTED FROM THE CITY OF NEWCASTLE TO THE JOINT POWERS BOARD

Deputy Attorney Jeani Stone presented a Resolution to the Board rerouting E-911 funds from the City of Newcastle to the Joint Powers Board. Discussion ensued. Vice-Chairman Todd moved to authorize the Chairman's Signature on Resolution 2023-29 – Redirecting 911 Emergency Tax Monies within Weston County, Wyoming; seconded by Commissioner Taylor. Carried.
