

1st Sunday of Lent: The Goodness of Creation, Part 1

Focus: God creates man and woman in his image and likeness

1. Quick Review:

- a. One goal: Tell the story
 - Kerygma:
 - 1. The Goodness of Creation
 - 2. Sin and its Consequences
 - 3. God's Response to Sin
 - 4. Our Response to God
- Key verse: "I am not ashamed of the Gospel: it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who has faith" (Romans 1:16).

2. This week and next: Part One: The Goodness of Creation

- a. Worldview of Genesis:
 - i. One God, who is really good,
 - 1. Elohim (God) and YHWH (LORD) (Gen. 1:1... and Gen. 2:4...)
 - ii. He creates everything out of nothing, freely, effortlessly, because he loves
 - Everything he creates is good and has a purpose.
 - iv. Highlight of creation: human person Genesis 1:26-27
 - 1. Created in God's own image and likeness:
 - a. Able to represent God on earth
 - b. Commissioned to exercise dominion
 - c. Capacity for reason and critical thinking.
 - 2. Humans are free.
 - a. Freedom vs. Lawlessness
 - b. Animals are slaves to instinct; humans can choose otherwise
 - c. Purpose of freedom? Love.
 - 3. "Male and female he created them."
 - a. Equal, but different
 - b. Ezer: "suitable partner"? (Genesis 2:18)
 - c. Need in our world; healthy men and women side-by-side
 - v. Genesis 1:29-30: "I have given you..."
 - We are creatures, dependent beings. We need.
 - God provides for us. He cares for his creatures.
 - 3. Nothing dies in Paradise. Death was not part of the plan.
 - vi. Genesis 2:1-3: He rested on the seventh day.
 - Made in his image and likeness. We are created to enter into his rest.
 - 2. We have a need for leisure.

- Do you understand that you have incredible value to God, that you matter to him?
- Do you believe that God is good?
- 3. Read 2 Peter 1:3-4


