Town Board Meeting 9-13-21

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting of the Town of Eaton was called to order by Chairman Rick Christel at 6:30 p.m., Monday, September 13, 2021 at the Eaton Town Hall. The Pledge Allegiance to the flag was recited by all.

MEETING NOTICES: Meeting notices were posted at the Eaton Town Hall and the Town Website

ROLL CALL: Rick Christel, Chairman; Adam Schetter, Supervisor, Lewy Schema, Supervisor, Paulette Vogt, Clerk, Pam Schneider, Treasurer, Curt Green, Constable, and Craig Zipperer, Road Superintendent, were in attendance along with Randy Knier.

AGENDA: The agenda had been emailed previously. Supervisor Schema made a motion to accept the agenda with the correction that part (a) – (Schneider/Road Damage Marsh and Hickory Hills Roads) of the Chairman's report be canceled due to Mr. Schneider not being able to make it to the September Board Meeting, Supervisor Schetter 2nd the same, and motion carried.

MINUTES: The minutes from the August 9, 2021 board meeting had been emailed to the Board previously. Supervisor Schetter made a motion to accept the minutes, Supervisor Schema 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

PUBLIC INPUT: There was no public input so Chairman Christel closed public input.

ROAD SUPERINTENDENT: Superintendent Craig Zipperer reported on the many jobs he has been doing this month to include working at the cemetery, doing culvert work with help of the Town of Liberty and the Town of Newton. In turn Craig returned the help to the two towns. Craig further reported that 6 road signs have been stolen. A culvert was replaced on Carstens Lake Road also

SUPERVISOR 1: Supervisor Adam Schetter asked Craig Zipperer about the pothole on Glen Flora Road. Craig reported that it had been fixed now.

SUPERVISOR 2: No report

TREASURER' REPORT: Treasurer Pam Schneider reported \$221,507.42 was the ending balance for August in the Bank First Elite Account. She further reported that there is \$14,262.73 in the Bank First Checking Account. The Road Maintenance Account has a \$25,378.61 balance, the Road Equipment has a \$10,000 balance, the Dog Fund has a \$1,025.56 balance, and the checking account interest has a balance of \$576.62

Supervisor Schema made a motion to accept the treasurer's report and Supervisor Schetter 2nd the same. Motion carried.

CONSTABLE'S REPORT: Constable Green said he received a call about a dog hit on the road. He had nothing further to report.

ASSESSOR'S REPORT: No Report

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT:

Kiel Ambulance Presentation: Jamie Aulik, Chief Bob Henning, and Dick Isley were in attendance to represent the Kiel Ambulance. Kiel would like to upgrade to paramedic service and have the service up and running by the end of next year. At least one paramedic would be on an ambulance call. The cost per capita would be kept at \$3.25. At this time they are presenting their plan to the surrounding townships so that the townships can talk about this during their budget process. After some discussion and questions, Chairman Christel thanked the three men for their presentation. The Board will be discussing this plan in the coming months.

Recycling Center Disposal Contract: Road Superintendent Zipperer received a quote from GFL for taking care of the town's recycling. Chairman Christel stated he had talked with the Town's Attorney and she will be composing a letter to the town's present recycling hauler to request a release for the town from it's present contract. If/when the town receives the release from the contract, a decision can then be made about what the town wants to do about the recycling matter.

Greendale/Town Line Roads Intersection Rebuild: After some discussion, a motion was made to hire Kartechner for \$28,540.30 to pulverize, regrade, and to pave 4 inches HMA at the said area intersection with the approval from the Town of Schleswig. The town of Schleswig has agreed to pay ½ of the cost as this intersection is also in their township. Chairman Christel 2nd the motion. Motion carried. Chairman Christel will get in touch with the Town of Schleswig about this.

Culvert on Quarry Road: Mr. James Downey came and asked the town if the culvert on Quarry Road could be lowered. His family would like to work the land but the land is continually wet. Chairman Christel said that Mr. Downey would have to get the correct permits from the DNR for this kind of work. Chairman Christel thanked Mr. Downey for coming and explaining his request.

Approve Vouchers: August Vouchers were paid with a motion from Chairman Christel and a 2nd from Supervisor Schema in the amount of \$106,705.17. Motion carried.

MEETING REPORTS: Chairman Christel reported that there will be a WTA Manitowoc County Unit Meeting at Kossuth Town Hall on September 16, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.

MISCELLANEOUS: No report.

CLERKS REPORT: No report

With no further business to report, Supervisor Schema made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor Schetter 2nd the same. Motion carried.
