

Vandoren Introduces the Juno Reed for Beginners



Vandoren has launched a new reed specially crafted for beginners. Designed with techniques mastered by the Van Doren family, reeds are produced in their factory in the south of France. **The Juno reed is the first student reed Vandoren has made in its 105 year history.** Rather than design a generalist reed that may be acceptable to a wide range of consumers, Juno is designed specifically so each beginning student experiences a high level of success.

What sets this reed apart from other beginner reeds?

First - Vandoren uses the same cane. In fact, everything about the way JUNO reeds are made is the same as any other Vandoren reed.

Second - Vandoren has designed a profile that is suited to beginners. This profile results in a reed that vibrates like other inexpensive reeds, but sounds like a Vandoren. Technology is the secret, but the ability to design a beautiful sounding reed is all Vandoren.

The JUNO reed costs the same as other entry level reeds but sounds *so much* better.

Juno reeds come in half-strengths from 1 1/2 to 3 and are available in boxes of ten for clarinet and alto sax or in convenient three-packs for clarinet, alto sax and tenor sax. **Only available at:**
