CALL TO ORDER: The monthly meeting of the Town of Eaton was called to order by Chairman Rick Christel at 6:30 p.m., Monday, August 11, 2020 at the Eaton Town Hall. The Pledge Allegiance to the flag was recited by all.

MEETING NOTICES: Meeting notices were posted at the Eaton Town Hall, Recycling Center, Riesterer & Schnell, Inc. and the Town Website

ROLL CALL: Rick Christel, Chairman; James Lax, Supervisor, Lewy Schema, Supervisor, Paulette Vogt, Clerk, Craig Zipperer, Road Superintendent were in attendance along with Randy Knier. Pam Schneider, Treasurer was excused.

AGENDA: The agenda had been emailed previously. Supervisor Schema made a motion to accept the agenda, and Supervisor Lax 2nd the same, motion carried.

MINUTES: The minutes from the July 13, 2020 board meeting had been emailed to the Board previously. Supervisor Lax made a motion to accept the minutes, Supervisor Schema 2nd the motion, carried.

PUBLIC INPUT: Randy Knier reported that there were complaints that the dumpster was too high to reach. Craig Zipperer will look into this matter. With no further public input, Chairman Christel closed the same.

ROAD SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT: Road Superintendent Craig Zipperer reported many of the jobs he has been doing for the month to include but not limited to: Cutting ditches, taking cardboard and glass into the recycling center, doing some wedging, putting down some patchwork on Greendale Road, cutting the grass at the cemetery, pumping water out at the end of Newton Road, putting a new tile line at Newton Road and Lax Chapel Road, fixing sign holders for road signs, and starting to mow the ditches. Craig further stated that Pat's Tire came and installed the new tires on the tractor. Craig had problem with the gears going out on the grader and had this fixed also.

SUPERVISOR #1 REPORT: No report.

SUPERVISOR #2 REPORT: No report.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Clerk Paulette Vogt read the report from Treasurer Pam Schneider which reported \$384,330.89 was the ending balance for July in the Bank First Checking Account. The Road Maintenance Account has a \$25,378.61 balance, the Road Equipment has a \$10,000 balance, and the Dog Fund has a \$1,025.56 balance.

Supervisor Lax made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Supervisor Schema 2nd the same. Motion carried.

CONSTABLE'S REPORT: No report.

ASSESSOR'S REPORT: No report. Treasurer Pam Schneider had reported she had not received any billing from the Building Inspector for a couple of months. Chairman Christel will look into this matter.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT:

Water problem at dead-end of Newton Road: After some discussion it was decided not to take action at this time and wait until budget time to discuss this problem.

Town Line and Greendale Road intersection problem: There is heaving on the road by Schuler Farm. Northeast Asphalt had not given us a quote on this. Road Superintendent Zipperer will call Mike from Northeast Asphalt and ask him what he can do to fix this. A possible solution would be to take the black top out and fix it with hot mix. The subject was tabled and no further action was taken.

Culverts at Twin Lakes Road and Town Line Road: The culvert that is there is the Town's culvert. Road Superintendent Zipperer will check into this as the culverts have to be taken care of.

Town Advocacy: After some discussion, a motion was made by Supervisor Lax and 2nd by Supervisor Schema to become a member of the Town Advocacy Council with the WTA. The Town will put this into the budget for the 2020-2021 year.

Road Superintendent Contract: After some discussion, the contract was tabled for the next monthly meeting in September.

APPROVE VOUCHERS: A motion was made by Supervisor Lax and 2nd by Supervisor Schema to pay the vouchers for July in the amount of \$63,757.28. Motion Carried.

MEETING REPORTS: There will be a Town Association meeting on October 18 at Meats in St. Nazianz sponsored by the Town of Eaton. Drinks and Ice Cream would be served.

MISCELLANEOUS UPDATES: No report

CLERK's Report: Clerk Vogt had no report

ADJOURNMENT: With all necessary business having been completed, Supervisor Schema made a motion to adjourn. Chairman Christel 2nd said the motion. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:17 p.m.
