[10] WAYS TO HELP MAKE COOKING TIME FAMILY TIME

- 1. TURN OFF THE TELEVISION at mealtime.
- 2. SHARE RESPONSIBILITY for all aspects of the meal with your children.
- SHOP FOR DINNER WITH YOUR CHILDREN, giving them an opportunity to suggest new things.
- ESTABLISH A BUDGET for each food category, so when you're shopping they begin to see that prepared foods are expensive and fresh foods go a long way.
- START WITH RECIPES YOU KNOW THEY LOVE, explaining that if they want to eat it, they have to help make it.
- For the very apathetic eater, BEGIN BY ASKING YOUR CHILD TO HELP WITH A SIMPLE FRUIT DESSERT.
- MAKE THE DINNER TABLE SACRED by keeping it permanently set with a tablecloth & cloth napkins (all washable), with designated places for each family member (so linens can get washed once a week).
- **8.** WAIT UNTIL ALL FAMILY MEMBERS ARE SEATED & SERVED before anyone is permitted to begin eating.
- MAKE IT CLEAR: AT DINNER TIME YOU'RE ONLY AVAILABLE IN THE KITCHEN; if they need you, they are welcome to join you there.
- 10. KEEP DINNER TIME DISCUSSION (DURING COOKING & EATING) TO TOPICS THAT WILL BE OF INTEREST TO YOUR CHILDREN.
