Purpose

The Paso Robles Youth Sports Council is a not for profit, public benefit organization 501(3)(c). The PRYSC is organized for the purpose of supporting other publicly supported youth sports organizations; to provide a forum through which independent sports groups can advise and petition the City of Paso Robles and area schools (local agencies) on matters relating to youth and adult athletic activities in the City of Paso Robles and the Paso Robles School District. In order to accomplish that purpose, the PRYSC may consult with and advise the local agencies on the matters which deal with:

- A. Athletic Field Use
- B. Athletic Field/Facility Improvements
- C. Athletic Field/Facility Development
