

Inclement Weather Policy

We will close if the Schuylkill Valley School District is closed for *inclement weather*. However, we do not delay the start of class. If Schuylkill Valley has a two-hour morning delay, our morning class will be canceled. We will hold the afternoon class if weather permits. Check our Facebook page, or call Mrs. Lash. If bad weather should occur during the morning class, then it may be necessary to close for the afternoon. Again, we will try to convey this information to our families in a timely manner. However, parents and caregivers will need to make the decision to transport their child during times of possible or actual inclement weather.

CLASS NOTES

The Thursday class began their fire safety unit by learning to dial 911. They learned about what constitutes an emergency and instances where they might be the one needed to call 911. They learned what EXIT signs are and the importance of knowing where they are located. We will finish our fire safety unit in November. They practiced the letters L,l and E,e. They learned about gun safety with Officer Wiley and learned the phrases to help keep them safe. Our Thursday students do need to learn their home addresses.

Both classes learned the nursery rhyme “Peter, Peter Pumpkin Eater”. We will be doing more nursery rhymes throughout the year. Nursery rhymes are terrific pre-reading skills. Vocabulary, rhyming words and fluency are a big part of nursery rhymes.

In November we will learn about kindness. We will discuss the Thanksgiving holiday and what it means to be thankful.


