

**Noah Rogers (1732-1810)**  
Private, Connecticut Militia

Noah Rogers was born in Branford, Litchfield, Connecticut May 8, 1732. He married Rhoda Leete (1739-1812) on October 23, 1765 at Guilford, New Haven, Connecticut.

Noah Rogers was a volunteer Private at the time of General Burgoyne's surrender. It was said that he brought home captured British musket as a trophy.

He spent most of his life near his home in Cornwall, Connecticut. Noah died in 1810 and was buried in North Cornwall Cemetery in Cornwall, Litchfield, Connecticut.
