He is an anointed powerful preacher of the gospel who shares God's love with all through genuine pastoral care. His mission for ministry is to nurture and empower those whom God has called him to serve, through Prayer, Care, Scripture and Education.

Under his servant leadership as a pastor for 18 years he has led many souls to Christ. He has served the St. Matthew Church since 2010.
