The Pearls of Wisdom Foundation provides scholarships to graduating high school seniors seeking to attain higher education, provides services to the community and promotes educational activities.

Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated ® - Pi Theta Omega Chapter was chartered on May 31, 1986. This marked the establishment of the first African American Greek Letter organization in Morristown, NJ and the beginning of what will be a long legacy of Alpha Kappa Alpha sisterhood and service to the community.

The Marjorie M. Herbert Scholarship is given to a student who plans to enroll or who currently attends an historically black college or university (HBCU). The scholarship is named after Mrs. Marjorie M. Herbert who attended and graduated from Morgan State University in Baltimore, Maryland, an historically Black university. She is a Charter member of Pi Theta Omega and a dedicated Morris County Community leader.

Eligibility Criteria for Continuing HBCU Students:

- ❖ Be an African American college student continuing his/her education at an HBCU
- Be a resident of Morris County and/or a former participant in a Pi Theta Omega high school program
- ❖ Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- ❖ Be able to attend the Chapter's Scholarship Awards Presentation Event tentatively scheduled for Saturday, June 16, 2018

To be considered for the Marjorie M. Herbert HBCU Scholarship, the completed application including all recommendations and transcripts must be postmarked by **April 16, 2018**. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

- Two letters of recommendation Both can be from an academic college professor Or one can be from an academic college professor while the other can be from a minister, coach, high school teacher or employer (or other adult). Please do not send recommendations from family members.
- 2. 300 500 word essay. Topic choices are A or B listed below: Select one.
 - **A.** Please tell us about a role model in your life. Explain how this person has influenced your life and your ability to mentor others.
 - **B.** When a sports athlete first took a knee, it was reportedly as a way to show support for disenfranchised people in the United States and to protest police brutality. Since then many athletes and celebrities have taken a knee. However, others have seen the taking a knee as disrespectful to those who serve in our armed forces. Do you think taking a knee is the right way to protest? Do you think it is offensive to the men and women who serve/served in the armed forces?
