The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by HOA president Cindy Ragan.

Randy (Common Area Committee chair) discussed fire mitigation. On 19 May he will resubmit requests for fire mitigation grants. Grant decisions are expected by 1 July. Randy will re-canvas residents for new interest in applying for a grant.

Ben M. will continue with mowing common areas this summer. Randy volunteered to cut down the dead tree at the north entrance to the neighborhood.

Cindy reports there is nothing new to report on BLM access issues.

Mike (Treasurer) reported \$42,302 in checking account and \$6,560 in savings are reconciled through March.

Propane: M&M Cathodics reports they are still collecting bids. The leak test must be completed this year. We will need a long-term plan to address future funds needed to maintain the system. This will be a topic of discussion at the full HOA meeting in July.

Cindy stated that resident Terry Sarver is now maintaining the entrance video cameras.

The board will plan to meet again on 2 June to begin developing a propane plan. Members who have been involved with the propane training are also invited to attend.

Lisa stated that some enforcement methods of residents not complaining with the architectural control committee requirements will be needed and should be included in ACC approval letters when requests are submitted. She reports several residents have not followed the plan submitted plans that were approved by the ACC.
