Representing the UOPX are team captain Katrina Ballard, Mary Peralta, and David Cooper--competing in Division Two at the Graduate Level. The competition will be held in Salt Lake City, Utah on April 29-30. This year's competition includes SHRM student teams competing from foreign countries. The winning team will be rewarded with an all-expense paid trip (\$2500) to Washington, D.C. for the 2016 National SHRM Conference and a team plaque, to be presented during the Saturday Awards Ceremony held at each of the 2016 Case Competition and Career Summit events (East, Central and West).

The 2016 SHRM Student Case Competition and Career Summit is the premier student HR conference in the United States. SHRM provides world-class opportunities for students, student chapter advisors, faculty members and HR professionals to connect through events held in multiple locations across the country. The Case Competition provides a realistic preview of the types of problems that students may eventually encounter in the workplace. The case study focuses on any number of HR/workplace issues and require strategic thinking, ethical decision-making, and strong leadership and presentation

SHRM Foundation Susan R. Meisinger Fellowship for Graduate Study in HR

The **Susan R. Meisinger Fellowship for Graduate Study in HR** is a premier source of funding for first-time master's degree students in Human Resources. The award honors former SHRM President & CEO, Susan R. Meisinger, SPHR.

The fellowship is designed to support master's degree students who are either members of SHRM or certified HR professionals. Sponsored by the SHRM Foundation, the fellowship supports those who want to leverage significant past contributions to the HR management field and who plan to continue contributing to the profession by earning a master's degree in HR.

One winner is selected annually to receive a fellowship of up to \$10,000. Additional fellowships may be awarded, depending on funding available, quantity and quality of applicants, and the discretion of SHRM. Each fellowship is renewable for one additional year for a total of two years of graduate study and up to \$20,000 total for the fellowship. Doctoral students, including DBAs and Ph.D.s, are not eligible for this award.

Applications will not be returned. **Completed applications must be received by Monday, August 15, 2016.** All applicants will be notified of results via mail by the first week of October.
