ORDINANCE NO. 18- 03
THE CITY OF VIENNA, ILLINOIS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 35.15 (FEES FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT RESPONSE) OF CHAPTER 35 (FINANCE) OF TITLE III (ADMINISTRATION) OF THE VIENNA CODE OF ORDINANCES

A. WHEREAS, Section 5/11-6-10 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-6-10) authorizes municipalities to fix, charge, and collect fees for the cost of services rendered by a volunteer municipal fire department for persons, businesses, and other entities who are not residents of the municipality.

B. WHEREAS, the City of Vienna operates a volunteer fire department that renders mutual aid to other jurisdictions and provides services for persons, businesses, and other entities who are not residents of the municipality.

C. WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Vienna have determined that it is necessary and in the best interests of the City of Vienna to amend the fees charged by the City of Vienna for services rendered to persons, businesses, and other entities who are not residents of the City of Vienna in order for the Vienna Fire Department to continue to be able to provide those services.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Vienna as follows:

1. That Section 35.15 (FEES FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT RESPONSE) of Chapter 35 (FINANCE) of Title III (ADMINISTRATION) of the Vienna Code of Ordinances shall be amended to read as follows:
 - (A) Fees imposed by ordinance of the city for services provided by the City Fire Department outside of the corporate limits are hereby increased to a minimum charge of \$1,000.
 - (B) The above increase is inapplicable to mutual aid calls and MABAS requests from other fire departments.
 - (C) The following additional charges will apply at the following rates to calls lasting more than ~~two~~ one hours in duration or if more than one gallon of foam is used in conjunction with the said call:
 - (1) Trucks: \$250 per hour:
 - (2) Firefighters: ~~\$20~~ \$70 per hour; and
 - (3) F-500 and/or AR-AFFF foam: \$25 per gallon.
 - (D) Charges to and by the U.S. Forest Service will be negotiated in an exclusive mutual aid agreement between the city and the U.S. Forest Service.

(E) The above fees may be reduced on an individual case-by-case basis by motion of the City Council.

2. This ordinance repeals any prior ordinances, resolutions, or portions thereof in conflict herewith.

3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval, and publication, as required by law.
