Israel Itinerary

Day 1, Monday, Travel from LAX

Day 2, Tuesday, Arrive in Tel Aviv. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

Day 3, Wednesday, Visit Israeli Museum with Model of Jerusalem and Shrine of the Book. Continue to Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial. End the day with the Garden Tomb. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

Day 4, Thursday, Mount of Olives; from viewpoint, Pater Noster, St. Mary Magdalene for time of devotion, Dominus Flevit, and Garden of Gethsemene. After lunch, visit St. Peter's in Gallicantu and the stone pit where Jesus was held (Caiaphas' Palace). End the day at the Western Wall. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

Day 5, Friday, In Bethlehem; Church of the Nativity and Shepherd's Field. (If possible, visit Nativity Church in the evening when less crowded). Lunch at the Grotto. After a time of shopping, head to the Old City of Jerusalem to visit the Holy Sepulchre and a bit of time to walk in the city. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

Day 6, Saturday, Begin the day by driving south along the Dead Sea to visit the fortress of Masada, taking a cable car to the top. You will then visit Ein Gedi. After lunch in Jericho and visiting the Mt. of Temptation for a view, you will have the opportunity to float in the Dead Sea. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

Day 7, Sunday, Today you will check out of the hotel. Early start for the Temple Mount. You will then drive north through the Jordan Valley, stopping at Beit She'an, where King Saul's head was hung on the city gate. If possible, visit Mt. Precipice or Church of the Annunciation on this day. You will then be overnight in Galilee area.

Day 8, Monday, Drive north to Caesarea Philippi and Tel Dan. After lunch, visit Bethsaida, fishing village of Peter, Andrew, and Philip. Continue to Kursi where the well-known story of the casting out of the demons into the swine takes place. Overnight in Galilee area.

Day 9, Tuesday, Sea of Galilee, including; Mt. of Beatitudes, Tabgha, the place of Jesus' miracle of the Multiplication of the Fish and Loaves, Primacy, Capernaum: known as "Jesus' hometown." You will take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. You will have also a St. Peter's fish lunch. End the day at Yardenit Baptismal site. Overnight in Galilee area.

Day 10, Wednesday, Check out of the hotel. Visit Nazareth Mt. Precipice and/or Church of the Annunciation. Continue to Mt. Carmel; commemorating the story of Elijah and the prophets of Ba'al. After lunch, continue to Caesarea Maritima and the aqueduct. You will have a farewell dinner tonight. Overnight in Tel Aviv or possible night flight back to the U.S.

Day 11, Thursday, Arrive back to the U.S.
