## Event Format

## FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 6TH

- Qualifying - Each driver will have 1 attempt of 2 continuous laps beginning at $6: 15$ pm. Once you pull on track, that is your attempt. Cars must go thru and pass tech as this is the qualifying line. Cars must be in the qualifying line/line for tech by no later than $6: 35 \mathrm{pm}$. The 10 fastest qualifiers will earn a locked in position to the 3-Hour Figure 8 starting lineup and participate in Saturday's qualifying session \#1. Friday qualifying times do not carry over to Saturday unless Saturday's qualifying gets rained out.
- Qualifying Race \#1 - Starting lineup is straight up for drivers who qualified 11, 13, 15, 17, 19, $21,23,25,27,29,31$, and so on. Cars must go thru and pass tech before going on track for the start. Race is contested under Speedrome regular season rules with racing under the yellow flag. Top 5 finishers will earn a locked in position to the 3-Hour Figure 8 starting lineup and participate in Saturday's qualifying session \#1. Drivers finishing outside the top 5 will participate in Saturday's qualifying session \#2.
- Qualifying Race \#2 - Starting lineup is straight up for drivers who qualified $12,14,16,18,20$, $22,24,26,28,30,32$, and so on. Cars must go thru and pass tech before going on track for the start. Race is contested under Speedrome regular season rules with racing under the yellow flag. Top 5 finishers will earn a locked in position to the 3-Hour Figure 8 starting lineup and participate in Saturday's qualifying session \#1. Drivers finishing outside the top 5 will participate in Saturday's qualifying session \#2.
- Additional Qualifying Race - If more than 50 cars qualify on Friday, the track has the option to add a 3rd qualifying race. Format will be like above with drivers being spread evenly across all 3 races. The difference would be only the top 4 finishers locking in to the 3 -Hour Figure 8 starting lineup from each race. This would expand the 3 -Hour Figure 8 starting field to 30 cars.


## SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 7TH

- Qualifying Session \#1 - This session is for the locked in drivers from Friday night and will set straight up starting spots 1 thru 20 (or thru 22 if 3 qualifying races were held). Each car is permitted as many attempts as the session time allows with the best single lap time being set as their official qualifying time. Each attempt is 2 laps. When the time runs out on the session, no other cars will be allowed an attempt. A car already on track can complete their attempt.
- Qualifying Session \#2 - This session is for those not locked in from Friday night. This session will set straight up starting spots 21 thru 28 (or 23 thru 30 if 3 qualifying races were held) and the order of the alternates. Each car is permitted as many attempts as the session time allows with the best single lap time being set as their official qualifying time. Each attempt is 2 laps. When the time runs out on the session, no other cars will be allowed an attempt. A car already on track can complete their attempt.
- Pre-Race Festivities - These are to honor you in front of the biggest crowd in Figure 8 racing! Be proud and get out on track. All starting field cars must be thru tech and on the track by $6: 45 \mathrm{pm}$. The gate will be closed at $6: 45 \mathrm{pm}$. Starting cars not on track by then may start the race from the pits. Very little leeway will be given. Also, drivers from the alternate line (without their cars) plus former winners of the event and not in competition, please be on track by 6:45pm. We will be introducing all of you.
