



# Firearms Qualification Standard For Missouri's Separated and Retired Law Enforcement Officers

## COURSE OF FIRE

### **Stage 1 Drill 1**

Weapon drawn from the holster/concealed  
Single target, 3 yard line  
2 rounds / 3 sec -(3 x's) Strong hand  
6 rounds total

### **Stage 1 Drill 2**

Weapon drawn from the holster/concealed  
Single target, 3 yard line  
3 rounds / 6 sec -(2 x's) Support hand  
6 rounds total

### **Stage 2 Drill 1**

Weapon drawn from the holster/concealed  
Single target, 5 yard line  
2 rounds / 3 sec -(3 x's) Strong hand  
6 rounds total

### **Stage 2 Drill 2**

Weapon drawn from the holster/concealed  
Single target, 5 yard line  
3 rounds / 6 sec -(2 x's) Support hand  
6 rounds total

### **Stage 3 Drill 1**

Weapon drawn from the holster/concealed  
Single target, 7 yard line  
14 rounds / 45 sec Two handed  
14 rounds total

### **Stage 4 Drill 1**

Weapon drawn from the holster/concealed  
Single target, 10 yard line  
3 rounds / 8 sec (2 x's) Two hand shooting  
6 rounds total

### **Stage 5 Drill 1**

Weapon drawn from the holster/concealed  
Single target, 12 yard line  
3 rounds / 10 sec (2 x's) Two hand shooting  
6 rounds total

Minimum Score

Total of 50 rounds

Minimum Score of 70%

35 of 50 rounds in the 8, 9, & 10 scoring area

## **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS**

- The B-27 target or its equivalent is required
- The qualification course of fire shall be conducted in daylight conditions
- An officer must qualify with the type of weapon that is to be carried
- The qualification course of fire must be administered by a certified firearms instructor
- The qualification course of fire may be conducted at a certified training school range, an agency range or a private range
- Remedial training and qualification may be conducted by the employing agency
