DESCRIPTION: Here is a good looking, serviceable Bear Polar. Bubinga riser. The early Polars were higher-end Bears, with attractive fiberglass overlays on the back of the bow (see pics). No delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes. The 61 Polar was the only year to feature "ice blue" colored limbs. These have been touched up, which is readily visible. The original decals are intact but discolored around the decal. A few underlying stress lines were filled with Loctite and touched up. No current stress lines or crazing. A few scratches, dings and scuffs on the riser and limbs. This is still a really nice bow for its age. This 1961 Polar was priced at \$50 when new (that translates to \$427 in 2019 inflation adjusted dollars). The 1961 Grizzly, by contrast, cost \$43, and the Kodiak \$59.
