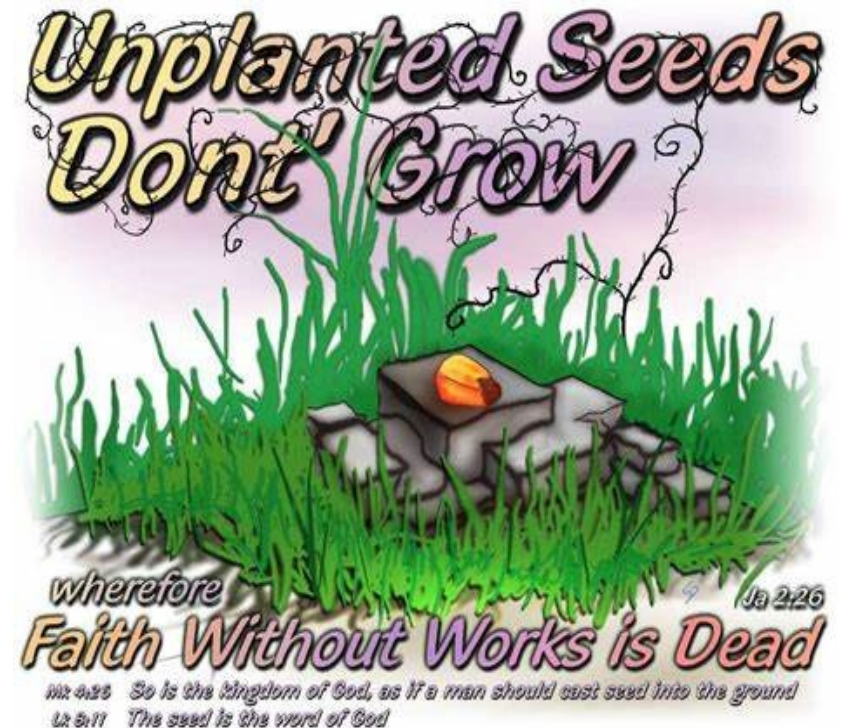

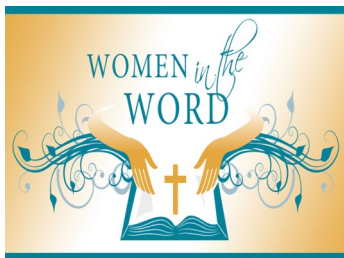
GRADUATION BANQUET is scheduled for Sunday, May 22nd, after evening services.

Poplar Log May 8-11. Brother Bill Watkins, son of James Watkins, will be the speaker.

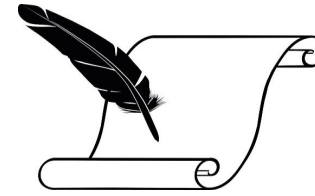

## JACK'S CORNER

### HERE'S LOOKING AT ME

*"Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you? - unless indeed you are disqualified."*

*2 Corinthians 13:5*

One of the hardest things to do is to look at ourselves honestly. We would like to think that we do not have too many faults, or bad traits. We seem to have an inborn defense mechanism that prevents us from being completely honest with ourselves, which makes self-improvement that much more difficult. But, as we look at the above verse, we see that we are to look closely at ourselves. What are we to look for? We must scrutinize our measure of faith. We must also test ourselves. Do we ever set spiritual challenges before ourselves? Spiritual challenges help us to grow and become stronger in the faith. Growing and becoming stronger in the faith is required by God (2 Peter 3:18).

The above scripture also asks us if we realize that Christ is in us. If we do not realize that Christ is in us, we will not likely live according to His standards. We must put forth a conscious effort each day to show the world that Christ is in us. The world will certainly know by our conduct whether He is, or not.

Some may fail the test. They may become disqualified. When one looks into the mirror of God's Word they will be able to determine whether or not they have passed or failed (James 1:23-25).

When we look into the spiritual mirror of the Word may we determine to correct any flaws that could cause us to lose our souls.
