

## April 30, 2017 Third Sunday of Easter Luke 24:13-35

## "And it happened that, while he was with them at table, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them."

When Jesus encountered two disciples on the road to Emmaus, it is clear that they did not understand all he had endured. He bluntly tells them, "Oh, how foolish you are! How slow of heart to believe all that the prophets spoke!" Despite his disappointment he did not abandon the two disciples, but "beginning with Moses and all the prophets, he interpreted to them what was referred to him in all the Scriptures." To paraphrase St. Augustine, Jesus is hidden in the Old Testament, and revealed in the New. How fortunate we are to have the faith of the apostles, the many disciples who followed them, and billions of Christians over two thousand years who believed that Jesus is the fulfillment of God's promise of salvation, forgiveness of sins and eternal life. Are we grateful for the gift of their faith? Do we accept and nurture our faith by daily or frequently reading God's Word revealed to us in the Old and New Testaments? When is the last time we read Sacred Scripture and listened for God to speak to us?

World Day of Prayer for Vocations - Called by Name Sunday May 7th, the Fourth Sunday of Easter is known as Good Shepherd Sunday. It has also been designated a World Day of Prayer for Vocations. This year marks its 54th year. As we celebrate the World Day of Prayer for Vocations, each parish in the Diocese of Owensboro has been invited to participate in CALLED BY NAME, a program of vocations awareness that offers an opportunity for us to pray for priestly vocations; to recognize gifts and potential for leadership and service in members of our parish; and finally, to call forth and encourage these members to share their gifts in priesthood. Perhaps you know a man (high school or older) who would, in your opinion, have the qualities to become a priest. We will follow up with them and offer resources for discernment and personally invite them to participate in our discernment programs such as, Come and See weekends, discernment retreats, and Made for More Camp.
