IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARADE ENTRIES

- 1. Parade Registration begins at 8am and ends at 9:30am at Vernonia City Hall.**
- Whether Pre-Registered or not, **ALL** entrants are to check in at the registration table.
- Parade fees must be paid at time of registration.
- Please go to your assigned staging area as directed. If there is an issue with your assigned staging area, please see the Parade Coordinator.
- Please read and follow the parade safety guidelines.
- 6. Judging begins at 9:30am and ends at 10:30am. You need to be registered by 9:30am if you wish to be judged and eligible for awards.**
- Awards will be presented before the parade starts.
- 8. Parade begins at 11am.**
- You will be directed by a parade official when it is your turn to enter the main parade route.
- Please display your entrant registration number in a visible location on your entry.
- Please keep pace with the parade.
- Please be careful when throwing candy or informational trinkets to the parade crowd.
- There is a 5-vehicle limit for trucks and car groups. No revving of engines.
- There is a limit of 10 for ATV (Please ride two by two). No revving of engines.



PARADE SAFETY GUIDELINES

Everyone loves a parade, yet they can present various risks for cities. For example, participants can fall off floats, be thrown from horses, or trip over potholes.

The following rules are intended to provide a safe and enjoyable parade.

General Safety Rules:

- Police and safety patrols requests should be followed in order to ensure the safety of parade participants and viewers
- The maximum, allowable height for floats is 14 feet
- No one should get on or off a float or entry once it has started down the parade route

Firearms:

- Loaded firearms are not permitted at any time

Smoking and Drinking:

- Smoking and the consumption of alcoholic beverages are not permitted on any parade entry at any time before or during the parade

Candy:

- People have been hurt as a result of candy being thrown during a parade
- Children can also get hurt if they compete to get the candy
- It is highly recommended that candy be handed out rather than thrown along the parade route

Water:

- Water should not be squirted or sprayed at parade viewers. Water balloons and squirt guns might sound like fun additions to a parade, but a water balloon bursting in a baby stroller can ruin an entire family's day

Sanitary Stations:

- Sanitary Stations are located throughout the city

Lost Children:

- Report lost children immediately to the Parade Coordinator or Police

Selection of Parade Participants:

- The Vernonia Friendship Jamboree and Logging Show does not discriminate

Horses:

- Horses should not be close to loud parade units such as motorcycles
- Horse riders are responsible for their own manure pick up

Insurance

- Every parade participant must sign a waiver of hold harmless
