

TACO MADRE SERVES MEXICAN PARRILLADA IN TWO LOCATIONS

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Family owned and operated, Taco Madre (named after the “mother” of all tacos) has two locations, one at 2112 Baseline Road in Montgomery (630/229-6481), the other at 352 N Randall Road in North Aurora (with patio, 630/340-4137).

Israel Garcia is CEO and manages the North Aurora store; Sean Artega is manager in Montgomery. For seven years, the family previously owned a restaurant in Mendota; but since opening locally in 2014, both area locations have built a loyal customer base.

Parrillada denotes “grilled” or char-broiled cooking which brings a distinctly different flavor to the food.


Specialties include Mexican (including grilled onions and Cilantro) or American style (including Mexican shredded cheese, lettuce and tomato) Tacos available in both 2 and 3 piece taco plates. Other unique Taco dishes are Premium Grilled Steak, Chilango (chopped steak, Chorizo, Jalapenos, grilled onions, melted cheese and Cilantro), Mahi Mahi & Shrimp (fish with Chipotle Mayo sauce, lettuce, Pico and avocado). Tortas and Burritos are served with Mexican shredded cheese, lettuce and tomato in several choices. A Burrito Bowl is served with rice, refried or black beans, choice of meat, lettuce, tomato and cheese.



Grilled Chicken Breast, Grilled Veggie plus the traditional Taco Salad are also available. Enchilada Dinners, served with rice and beans and Red or Green Mole, can be ordered in Cheese, Beef, Veggie, Chicken Breast, Steak or Shrimp varieties. Fajitas served with Tortillas, rice, beans Pico de Gallo, sour cream and Guacamole come with Chicken Breast, Steak, a combination of Chicken & Steak, Shrimp or Veggies.



The favorite specialty Parrillada dishes served with rice, beans and Tortillas include Carne Nortena (Sauteed Chicken Steak & Chorizo), Carne Asada (Premium Grilled Steak), a Taco Madre Combo (Grilled Steak with Chile Relleno), Tampiquena (Grilled Steak topped with a cheese Enchilada), Chimichanga (with choice of meat) and Chili Relleno (Poblano Pepper), all enhanced with appropriate add ons.



Breakfast served at Taco Madre with rice, beans and Tortillas include egg dishes Huevos con Chorizo, a la Mexicana or Rancheros. Twelve Appetizers and Side Orders plus Desserts (Fried Ice Cream, Flan or Sopapilla) round out the menu. Alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks include fountain drinks, bottle or cans of pop, bottled water, Jarritos, Imported and Domestic Beers, Horchata (rice water), Margaritas and Pina Coladas.

A kid friendly restaurant, children can enjoy a Junior Quesadilla or Burrito or Taco with choice of meat, fries or beans, rice and a drink.

Orders can be placed by calling ahead or with an online app at tacomadreonline.com. Catering for your party or other gathering offers several options of favorite selections. Delivery within five miles is available at a small cost.
