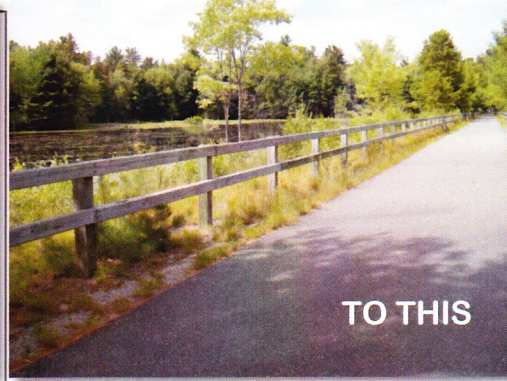
Lynnfield Rail Trail

When and How:

Still in the initial phase, this multi-step design and planning process is underway with State funded preliminary engineering work happening now in both Lynnfield and Wakefield.

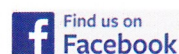
