

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-02

AN ORDINANCE providing for, and implementing, a tax levy for the 2022 real estate taxes payable in calendar year 2023.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the “Board of Trustees”) of the Mill Creek Water Reclamation District (the “District”) implemented a tax levy for 2021 real estate taxes payable in 2021 in the amount of \$33,200.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the District has determined that it is necessary and in the best interests of the District to implement a tax levy for 2022 real estate taxes payable in 2023 in the amount of \$33,200.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Mill Creek Water Reclamation District, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Tax Levy for 2021. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended by the District for the calendar year 2021 payable in 2022 and the property taxes extended by the District for debt service and public building commission leases for the calendar year 2021 and payable in 2022 were collectively, Thirty-Three Thousand Two Hundred and 00/100’s (\$33,200.00).

Section 2. Tax Levy for 2022. The Board of Trustees of the District has decided to proceed with and implement a tax levy for 2022 taxes payable in 2023 for corporate and special purposes and for debt service and public building leases in the amount of the lesser of (a) \$33,200.00 or (b) the maximum amount permitted by law. This represents an increase of \$0 over the amount of taxes levied for the year 2021 payable in 2022. The Board of Trustees hereby approves, authorizes and extends such tax levy for 2022 taxes payable in 2023. The President and Trustees of the District are hereby authorized to take any and all action and to execute and deliver any and all documents on behalf of the District as are appropriate in implementing or necessary to implement such tax levy, including without limitation, any certificates, certifications, statements, estimates and other documents required by the County of Kane or the State of Illinois.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provisions shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances, resolutions or orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provision of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.


