 Colorado St was +30.5 ATS points at Toledo in a 22-6 win (+14.5)  
 The Albany/Syracuse game went OVER the total by 45 points!  
 The Utah St/Air Force game went OVER the total by 40 points!  
 The Charlotte/Georgia St game went UNDER the total by 34 points!  
 Fresno St is 4-0 ATS this year with an average cover margin of 15.9 ppg!  
 Michigan is 3-0 ATS this year with an average cover margin of 19.0 ppg!  
 Ohio is 0-3 ATS this year failing to cover the spread by 22.8 ppg!  
 Rice is 0-3 ATS this year failing to cover the spread by 21.0 ppg!  
 The OVER is 3-0 in Army games going OVER by an average of 16.5 ppg!  
 The UNDER is 3-0 in Clemson games going UNDER by an average of 24.3 ppg!

### Misleading Finals

**Boston College beat Temple 28-3.** However, Temple actually had a 245-221 yard edge. Temple got SOD 3 times inside BC's 35-yard line.

**Cincinnati beat Indiana 38-24.** However, IU had a 376-328 yard edge but were done in by 4 TO's and a 99-yard kick return TD for Cincy.

**Clemson beat Georgia Tech 14-8.** However, GT had a 309-284 yard edge. GT had a 1st & Goal and the 3-yard line but were stopped on downs in the final seconds.

**Alabama beat Florida 31-29.** However, Florida won the box score with a 440-331 yard edge including 245-91 on the ground. Alabama led 21-3 after one quarter but the Gators were the much better team afterwards.

**Ohio St beat Tulsa 41-20.** However, OSU only had a 508-501 yard edge. OSU scored 2 TD's in the final 3:07 to pull away.

**Memphis upset Mississippi St 31-29.** It was arguably the most misleading final of the week. Miss St had 26-12 first down and 468-246 yard edges. Memphis got a 49-yard fumble return TD and a 94-yard punt return TD. The punt return was questionable to say the least.

**UTSA beat Middle Tennessee 27-13.** UTSA dominated more than the final with 23-11 first down and 452-199 yard edges including 175-8 on the ground. MT scored 2 TD's in the final 3:28 getting 123 of their yards on those two drives.

**East Carolina upset Marshall 42-38.** However, Marshall had a 647-561 yard edge but were -2 in TO's. Marshall led 38-21 in the fourth quarter! ECU got a TD with 2:31 left then got an onside kick and another TD with :55 left for the go-ahead.

**San Diego St upset Utah 33-31.** It was a misleading high score. Utah got a 80-yard punt return TD. San Diego St got a 100-yard kick return TD and it was 24-24 at the end of regulation.

**Northern Arizona upset Arizona 21-19.** However, Arizona had 19-15 first down and 363-240 yard edges. Arizona led 13-0 but an interception return TD right before the half changed momentum.

### Bad Beats

**Connecticut (+34.5)** got a backdoor cover TD on 4th&Goal with 1:10 left to "only" lose 52-31 to Army.

**Louisiana Tech was +350 on the money-line vs SMU.** However, SMU got a 33-yard "Haily Mary" TD pass on the final play of the game.

South Carolina/Georgia went OVER the total by 5 (loser) and Northwestern (-2.5) had no shot at all in a loss to Northwestern. The Arizona St/ BYU UNDER was a winner. On Sunday, the NFL went 2-1. Our top play Carolina was an easy outright winner over New Orleans. Meanwhile Big Ben and the Steelers looked like crap in an outright loss to the Raiders. Finally, the Vikings got the cover for us and probably should have won outright (missed FG on final play).

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**Games in Rotation Order**

**Thursday, September 23rd**

**APPALACHIAN ST 35 Marshall 26.** Marshall comes in after blowing a 17-point 4Q lead to East Carolina last week, the same ECU team that App St beat by 14 in the opener. The Herd offense is one of the most improved in the country this year averaging 604 ypg! However, they get their stiffest test of the season against a App St team that is looking for revenge for losing at Marshall last year. We lean with the home team and note a sharp betting group has pounded the OVER all week in this game. Marshall games are 3-0 to the OVER this year by an average of 10.7 ppg.

**Friday, September 24th**

**CHARLOTTE 28 Middle Tennessee 26.** MT QB Bailey Hockman was benched in last week's game vs UTSA and then quit the team earlier this week. We think the market has over-reacted to this news as Chase Cunningham has experience the last two years as the backup and has performed admirably in his action already this year (3-0 ratio). The offense was stinking up the joint anyways averaging just 54 rush ypg. Meanwhile, Charlotte comes in off their first loss of the season to Georgia St last week. We lean MT and also the UNDER which is 3-0 in Charlotte games this year by an average of 15 ppg!

**VIRGINIA 35 Wake Forest 31.** Wake comes in at 3-0 and have outscored their opponents by 26 ppg including a 35-14 win over Florida St last week (+4 in TO's). This will be their toughest test. Meanwhile, UVA QB Brennan Armstrong threw for 554 yards (school-record) and 4 TD's last week but their defense was gashed for 699 yards in a 59-39 loss at North Carolina. We lean UNDER here as even though Wake runs a ton of plays, the UNDER is 3-0 in their games this year.

**Liberty 30 SYRACUSE 23.** Liberty beat Syracuse 38-21 last year. The Flames have now covered 11 straight games dating back to last year by an average of 8.7 ppg and head coach Hugh Freeze is 67-35-1 ATS in his career. That's the best mark of any long-term coach in the country ATS wise. The Flames are +26 ppg and +199 ypg on the season so far as QB Malik Willis is completing 71% of his passes (7-0 ratio) and has 225 rushing yards and 4 TD's. They're taking on an improved Syracuse team that is off a blowout win over Albany. The Cuse rush D is allowing just 64 rush ypg. This line seems fair and we certainly can't go against the Liberty ATS streak.

**FRESNO ST 44 UNLV 14.** Fresno St is already 4-0 ATS on the season with an average cover of 15.9 ppg. Last week they upset UCLA as Fresno had 32-17 first down and 569-395 yard edges. QB Jake Haener threw for 455 yards (leads nation in passing yards). "I think the quarterback is a special player," UCLA coach Chip Kelly said. "We threw everything at him. We blitzed him, played cover zero, rushed three and dropped everyone else back into coverage. I think we threw the entire kitchen sink at him and he handled everything." UNLV won't have much to throw at Haener as the Rebels still haven't won a game under Marcus Arroyo. This year, the Rebels are -25 ppg and -267 ypg. They're playing musical chairs at QB again. The problem is we think you're starting to pay a premium on Fresno.

**Saturday, September 25th**

**MINNESOTA 42 Bowling Green 7.** BG is an improved team as they are 3-0 ATS this year (+11.8 ppg). However, we don't understand this line. In the opener the Falcons were getting 37 points at Tennessee. Minnesota is a much better team than Tennessee and yet this line has Minny favored by 31? Maybe it's because the Gophers haven't topped 31 points in any game this year. They are coming off a dominating 30-0 win over Colorado last week as they gave up MINUS-19 yards rushing! We think Minny rolls and it's one of our strongest power ratings' plays (see page 7).

**Kentucky 28 SOUTH CAROLINA 22.** Kentucky comes in at 3-0 but last week they had a poor performance in a 28-23 win over FCS Chattanooga as a 33-point favorite! Meanwhile, South Carolina moved to 3-0 ATS under first-year head coach Shane Beamer. They still lost 40-13 (+31.5) at Georgia as we lost the UNDER on these pages. Kentucky has won and covered 6 of the last 7 in this series. They win another here but we don't see much value.

† **Wisconsin 26 Notre Dame 18.** Played at Soldier Field in Chicago, IL. First meeting between these two in 57 years! Last week we faded Notre Dame on these pages and came up short. Purdue did have the yardage edge as ND is still only +27 ypg this year despite their 3-0 record. While Wisconsin is 1-1, their box scores have been dominant as they are +244 ypg and have out-rushed their opponents 263-33 on average. Meanwhile, ND has lost the line of scrimmage getting out-rushed 151-106 (-1.5 yards per carry). This is a bad match-up for ND's offensive line that's given up 14 sacks already. We like Wisconsin who is fresh off a bye.

**Toledo 30 BALL ST 26.** After their near upset of Notre Dame two weeks ago, the Rockets laid an egg at home vs Colorado St losing 22-6 as 14.5-point favorites. Speaking of laying eggs, that's all Ball St has done this season as they have a goose-egg in the cover department at 0-3 ATS (-18.5 ppg!). Last week, their 4-year starting QB Drew Plitt was benched in a 45-12 loss at Wyoming. We're not sure what to make of either team this year so far. Pass.

**WESTERN MICHIGAN 30 San Jose St 27.** Western Michigan comes in off a thrilling 44-41 win at Pitt last week as 14-point underdogs. Meanwhile, San Jose St could be road weary. This is the 3rd straight road game for the Spartans who won at Hawaii last week 17-13 despite getting out-gained 369-291. Their rush offense is averaging just 86 ypg this season. Our ratings say San Jose is the play here but the spot is probably worth a couple of points for WMU. We will lean with the UNDER as there is an over-reaction to Western's high scoring game last week.

**EASTERN MICHIGAN 32 Texas St 24.** Despite their 0-3 ATS mark on the season, we like Eastern Michigan here. It's more of a play against a Texas St team that's

been living a lie all year. The Bobcats were extremely fortunate to cover vs Baylor in the opener (only 235 yards of offense), somehow beat FIU in overtime (were +3 in TO's) and then last week they got their reckoning in an outright loss to FCS Incarnate Word. We also lean UNDER.

**MARYLAND 41 Kent St 28.** This has been a brutal non-conference schedule for Kent St who's already played Texas A&M and Iowa. Last week Kent St had a first-and-goal at the Iowa 1 in the 3Q but fumbled. "If we get the touchdown there, and the PAT, it's 16-14 and away we go," Kent State coach Sean Lewis said. Meanwhile, Maryland is 3-0 on the season but this could be a bit of sandwich game for them off a conference win over Illinois and they have a big conference game vs Iowa on a short week on deck. The Terps have been impressive at +248 ypg this season. Still, we lean with the dog here.

**PURDUE 33 Illinois 21.** Purdue disappointed us on these pages last week in their loss to Notre Dame. The Boilers did have a 348-343 yard edge and had a chance for the back-door cover but threw an interception in the end zone with 2:32 left. Meanwhile, Illinois has now lost 3 straight games after the opening upset of Nebraska. Last week, Maryland scored 10 points in the final 2:13 to win 20-17 over them thanks to some questionable coaching by Illinois' Bielema (big surprise...NOT). QB Peters was also a mess in his first start back from injury. We don't see much value here especially Purdue's best weapon WR David Bell questionable.

**COASTAL CAROLINA 53 Massachusetts 17.** Don't look now but UMass has covered back-to-back games and has found an offense with Brady Olson at QB. Last week they had 519 yards in a loss to Eastern Michigan. On the other side, Coastal only won by 3 at Buffalo. "We dropped a lot of passes that were big plays that could've went for touchdowns," Coastal Carolina coach Jamey Chadwell said. The Chants will get plenty of opportunities here vs a UMass defense allowing 46 ppg and 525 ypg. The OVER is 3-0 in UMass games by an average of 10.7 ppg. That's where our lean is here.

**CENTRAL MICHIGAN 36 Fiu 22.** The Chips are just 1-2 on the season but have played a pair of SEC teams. They are still +71 ypg on the season. Last week CMU took the unusual step of traveling to LSU on the day of the game and flying home without spending a night in Louisiana. There's a crunch on hotel rooms in the region since Hurricane Ida struck on Aug. 29. Now they face a FIU team that is 1-2 on the season and was thumped by Texas Tech last week. Another long road trip here for a FIU program that has slipped the last couple of years. We like CMU here.

**ARMY 30 Miami, Oh 21.** Miami got their first win of the season last week as their defense has allowed less than 300 yards each of the last two games. Meanwhile, Army is 3-0 so far this season and have been dominating their opponents at the line of scrimmage with a 331-69 rushing yard edge. Last week, they did get back-doored as a huge favorite vs UConn. It is very surprising that Army games are 3-0 to the OVER this year by an average of 16.5 ppg. However, we've seen a ton of money come in on the UNDER here (we bet UNDER 55.5 on Sunday). At the current lines, we don't see much value.

**OHIO ST 57 Akron 8.** This is a huge number to lay for a struggling Ohio St defense that is allowing 471 ypg and 29 ppg on the season. Last week's 41-20 win over Tulsa was misleading as OSU only had a 508-501 yard edge and the Buckeyes scored 2 TD's in the final 3:07 to pull away. However, we don't want Akron here who already lost 60-10 at Auburn this year. Keep an eye though on their QB DJ Irons who was 19 of 23 for 296 yards and a 3-0 ratio while also running for 136 yards and a TD last week in a win over FCS Bryant. Pass.

**UL-Lafayette 34 GEORGIA SOUTHERN 20.** We were really surprised the books opened ULL -10 in this one. Georgia Southern is a pathetic 0-3 ATS this year failing to cover by an average of 19.8 ppg. Last week, QB Justin Tomlin played his first game of the season. He was 11 of 23 for 65 yards in a blowout loss at Arkansas. The GS defense is allowing 534 ypg this year! Meanwhile, ULL should have gotten some confidence after blowing out Ohio last Thursday. We lean with them here but there's clear value lost since the opening line.

**Boise St 37 UTAH ST 30.** Boise State (1-2) hasn't lost two games this early in a season since 2005 when the Broncos started 0-2. Last week they blew a 20-7 lead at home to Oklahoma St. Boise had a chance to win but had a 36-yard FG blocked in the final minutes. The Broncos probably had that coming after back-to-back misleading covers. They have notably been out-rushed 202-67 on average so far. Meanwhile, Utah St is one of the most improved teams in the country. The Aggies are 3-0 straight up and 3-0 ATS with an average cover of 16.8 ppg. They've already pulled two big outright upsets this year...can they make it a 3rd? Note there is a ton of money coming in on the OVER here but we lean UNDER with a 10am local start.

**DUKE 35 Kansas 20.** We had a horrific loser playing against Duke last week. The Blue Devils led Northwestern 27-0 in the second quarter and held on for the outright upset 30-23. The Duke offense is averaging 524 ypg so far this season and should have a lot of success against a Kansas defense that was just run over by Baylor (307 rush yards) last week. The Jayhawks have looked at times improved this year. "Here we are in a one-possession game in the third quarter for the second consecutive week," Kansas coach Lance Leipold said, reflecting on a loss to Coastal Carolina last Friday, "and it kind of gets away from us. We have to find a way to overcome that." We prefer the UNDER here.

**BOSTON COLLEGE 29 Missouri 28.** This comes down to how much you value BC starting QB Phil Jurkovec who is probably out indefinitely. Last week BC really struggled throwing the football without Jurkovec as QB Grosel was only 7 of 15 for 59 yards vs a suspect Temple defense. On the other side, Missouri hasn't impressed us so far this year at 0-3 ATS. Their run defense is allowing 267 ypg so far. Our ratings say BC is the play but we didn't bet it.

**NORTHWESTERN 30 Ohio 15.** Two of the most disappointing teams in the country. Both are 0-3 ATS to start the season. Northwestern has failed to cover their games by 13.3 ppg and we lost on these pages backing them last week. "I would like to stop doing what losing teams do," Pat Fitzgerald said. "Losing teams turn the ball over. Losing teams have self-inflicted wounds. Losing teams give up explosive plays. Losing teams have communication issues. This is not hard. I'm not trying to discredit Duke, but we gift-wrapped it for them." Meanwhile, the Bobcats have been worst at a nation-worst -22.8 ATS ppg. We lean UNDER.

**North Carolina 37 GEORGIA TECH 24.** After a tough opening loss to Virginia Tech, the Tar Heels' offense is rolling piling up 59 points and 600 or more yards in back-to-back games. Last week QB Howell threw for 307 yards and 5 TD's and also ran for 112 yards in the 20-point win over UVA. Meanwhile, GT nearly pulled off a stunner as they fell 14-8 at Clemson. GT had a 1st & Goal at the Clemson 3-yard line but were stopped on downs in the final seconds. The defense has been much improved this year allowing just 18 ppg and 286 ypg. They'll get tested here. Pass. **IOWA 33 Colorado St 9.** The Hawkeyes continue to impress at 3-0 ATS (+13.2 ppg). It's not pretty on the offensive side but they did manage 418 yards last week. The defense is allowing just 81 rush ypg. Meanwhile, Colorado St got their first win of the season last week as 14.5-point underdogs at Toledo. CSU out-rushed Toledo 209-21 and a 70-yard punt return TD by Colorado St was the key play. It broke a 6-6 tie late 3Q. The UNDER is a perfect 3-0 in Iowa games this year and that is where our lean is.

**2★ OVER 64 Indiana 40 WESTERN KENTUCKY 29.** The Hoosiers are off to a disappointing 1-2 start. Last week, IU had a 376-328 yard edge but were done in by 4 TO's and a 99-yard kick return TD for Cincy. The momentum swung when Cincy QB Desmond Ridder took a big hit on third-and-10 late in the first half. A replay review resulted in a targeting call and the ejection of Hoosiers LB Micah McFadden. "We were dominating them till that point," Indiana coach Tom Allen said. "He's our leader, he's part of our pressure, he makes a lot of tackles, and when you lose a guy like that, that's tough." They take on a high-powered WKU offense that is averaging 532 ypg and 47 ppg. We do think this line is short on the favorite but we like the OVER. This is a completely different WKU team from the one that saw their games average 45 total ppg the last two years. The totals' market hasn't caught up yet.

**AIR FORCE 28 Florida Atlantic 24.** FAU has looked pretty good so far at 2-1 SU/ATS and are +131 ypg. After losing to Florida in the opener, they have dominated Georgia Southern and Fordham the last two weeks. They are taking on an Air Force team that should be plenty angry after blowing a double-digit 4Q lead to Utah St last week. Our power ratings like FAU here but this is a unique trip for them playing in the elevation. Does their defense wear down in the second half?

**UTAH 35 Washington St 21.** There's plenty of candidates but Utah gets our vote as the most disappointing team in the country so far. It's not just that they are 0-3 ATS (-10.8 ppg), it's how they've lost outright to BYU and San Diego St the last two weeks. The Utes have been owned at the line of scrimmage as they have been out-rushed and they have a negative sack differential! This was a team that was supposed to dominate the LOS this year. Last week QB Cam Rising gave their offense a spark off the bench. Starting QB Charlie Brewer then quit the team yesterday. We're not sure we want to lay points right now with them. Then again, Washington St is another total mess at 0-3 ATS (-18.3 ppg). After leading 14-0 vs USC last week, they allowed the game's final 45 points (to a backup QB). Pass.

**Hawaii 41 NEW MEXICO ST 23.** This is the first of two meeting this year as New Mexico St travels to Hawaii on October 23rd. Hawaii is just 1-3 SU/ATS this season. Their offense has been averaging 416 ypg but their defense is allowing 430 ypg. Don't look now but New Mexico St has covered 3 straight games. Last week they got their first straight up win but it came against lowly South Carolina St of the FCS. The Aggies have been playing with a 3rd string QB and they could get one of their top 2 back this week. We lean OVER.

**BYU 37 South Florida 16.** What a start for BYU at 3-0 SU with all 3 wins coming against Pac-12 schools. After upsetting in-state rival Utah, the Cougars pulled off another upset last week over Arizona St. It should be noted BYU is -32 ypg. This is the type of game that has given head coach Kalani Sitake fits in the past including a loss at South Florida in 2019. It's tough seeing USF pulling off an upset here considering their defense is allowing 524 ypg and physical NC State and Florida teams ran over them. Still, we wouldn't be surprised if the Cougars were a little flat.

**ARIZONA ST 27 Colorado 16.** These two teams are a combined 6-0 to the UNDER this year. We cashed backing the UNDER in the Arizona St/BUU game last week on these pages and now the Sun Devils take on a struggling Colorado offense that has managed just 7 points combined the last two weeks. Last week, they were crushed by Minnesota 30-0. "That was a complete, I would say, beatdown in every way," Colorado coach Karl Dorrell said. Buffs games have went UNDER by 22.2 ppg and that's where our lean is. It's also tough trusting a ASU team that has looked distracted this year (off-field allegations) at 0-3 ATS (-12.7 ppg).

**Ucla 30 STANFORD 28.** Just when you thought UCLA had turned the corner, they come in off the bye and lose outright to Fresno St last week. While Fresno needed a last-second TD to beat the Bruins, it should be noted that Fresno had 32-17 first down and 569-395 yard edges. Meanwhile, Stanford is off back-to-back wins and covers. The Cardinal have started the season playing the first three games on the road, the only Power 5 program this season to even play its first two straight games away from home. That's after playing the final four games of the 2020 season away from home because of the pandemic. "It's been a long time," Stanford coach David Shaw said. "We're excited. We're excited to finally be able to go home. It's been a long road trip." The Cardinal are 10-2 ATS as a home underdog with 9 outright upsets. That's where our lean is here.

**USC 38 Oregon St 24.** Our power ratings like USC here. The Trojans definitely showed off their talent level last week as despite playing with a backup QB, an interim coach and trailing 14-0 on the road, they scored the game's final 45 points and destroyed Washington St. Oregon St is a similar talented team as Washington St although better coached. The Beavers come in off back-to-back wins and covers. On paper this looks like a mismatch but let's see who plays at QB for USC as both Slovics and Dart are banged up. And let's also see USC play with more consistency.

**Louisville 30 FLORIDA ST 28.** Florida St is now a losing football program. They have had 3 straight losing seasons and are heading for a 4th. The Noles are 0-3 and will be an underdog in every game but two down the stretch (Syracuse and UMass at home). Meanwhile, Louisville got a big upset win over UCF last Friday. QB Cunningham was 23 of 38 for 265 yards and also ran for 99 yards and 2 TD's. Jaylin Alderman returned an interception off a tipped pass for a 66-yard touchdown with 13 seconds remaining. If Cunningham is healthy here (he was hobbling at the end of that UCF game), the Cardinals win here.

**2★ Kansas St (plus the points) OKLAHOMA ST 24 Kansas St 21.** An important game in the Big 12 with both of these teams already 3-0 on the season. We've been a little more impressed with Kansas St as they have owned the line of scrimmage with a dominating 226-55 rush advantage. They out-rushed Nevada 269-25 last week in a "upset". Meanwhile, Oklahoma St also controlled the line of scrimmage last week over a Mountain West opponent as the Cowboys out-rushed Boise St 246-61 in their 21-20 upset win. OSU RB Jaylen Warren ran for 218 yards and 2 TD's. The Pokes are banged up at WR as leading receiver Jayden Bray, Brayden Johnson, and Tay Martin were all out against Boise State — and it showed. We bet Kansas St +9 and UNDER 49.5. We still like Kansas St.

**ALABAMA 52 Southern Miss 7.** After Alabama led Florida 21-3 early last week, we turned our attention to other games. We were stunned to see Florida out-play the Crimson Tide for the final three quarters. They were nothing fluky about it as Florida won the box score with a 440-331 yard edge including 245-91 on the ground. Alabama won't have any problems here vs a Southern Miss team playing a back-up QB and we expect to see a full 60-minute effort here. Nick Saban "Our team needs to learn to maintain intensity throughout the game. ... We've got a lot of good players. We've just got to get them to play a little better."

**Georgia 44 VANDERBILT 8.** You can make a case that Georgia has been the most impressive team in the country so far (Michigan and Ole Miss would also have cases). The Bulldogs are +207 ypg and have given up only one TD on defense. Meanwhile, Vandy has played okay in spurts the last couple of weeks but will be completely over-matched here. UGA will have a large crowd edge here despite the game being in Nashville. We bet Georgia -31 on the openers but the line has now moved through "35".

**HOUSTON 34 Navy 14.** It will be very interesting to see how Navy responds in this game. The Middies were completely embarrassed in their first two games at home vs Marshall and Air Force getting outscored 72-10. Long-time offensive coordinator Ivin Jasper was fired by the AD only to have head coach Niumatalolo rehired Jasper as the QB coach. Yes, you read that last sentence right. Meanwhile, Houston's defense has allowed just 7 total points the last two games. However, their QB Clayton Tune is a bit banged up. We're passing.

**OKLAHOMA 38 West Virginia 21.** Our numbers like Oklahoma here. However, we haven't been overly impressed with them as they are 0-2 ATS vs FBS teams with a couple of close wins vs Tulane and Nebraska. The defense is allowing just 83 rush ypg. Meanwhile, West Virginia got a big win over Virginia Tech last week. WV led 27-7 late 3Q but VT had a 1st&Goal at the WVU 3-yard line in the final minute and couldn't score down 27-21. It was one of three Virginia Tech drives that stalled inside the West Virginia 10, with the Hokies coming away with no points. Since joining the Big 12, West Virginia is 0-8 straight up and is on a 0-5-1 ATS run v Oklahoma. We don't see much value here.

**MISSISSIPPI ST 29 Lsu 28.** Last week's biggest misleading final was Mississippi St's 31-29 loss to Memphis. Miss St had 26-12 first down and 468-246 yard edges. Memphis got a 49-yard fumble return TD and a 94-yard punt return TD. The punt return was questionable to say the least. The SEC issued a tweet after the game, arguing the punt return should have been reviewed after the back judge, part of an SEC officiating crew, had signaled to stop the clock after the punted ball stopped moving. Meanwhile, LSU played a solid game vs Central Michigan. Early money has come in on the dog and we agree.

**Wyoming 40 CONNECTICUT 12.** This is Wyoming's largest favorite role on the road since 1996. The Cowboys come in at 3-0 and played their best game of the season last week in a blowout win over Ball St. They now make the long trip east against what we currently think is the worst team in the country. The Huskies are -34 ppg and -288 ypg but did get a back-door cover vs Army last week. They also got a 96-yard kickoff return by Brian Brewton. It was UConn's first kickoff return for a TD since 2011. The points were the first for UConn against an FBS opponent this season. They won't score many here. We lean UNDER.

**TULANE 31 Uab 28.** Really good Group of 5 game here. How will Tulane respond after getting destroyed 61-21 by Ole Miss last week? UAB was in their position last week. The Blazers lost to Georgia 56-7 and then turned around and crushed North Texas 40-6. This is the 4th straight game away from home for them before they open up their new stadium next week. This is not a game we're looking to be involved in from a value aspect but we will get to learn a lot about both.

**TEXAS 34 Texas Tech 23.** This is one of the biggest line movers of the week. A professional bettor with serious market influence took Texas Tech but now we think the market has over-corrected itself. Texas is a different team with Casey Thompson at QB. Dating back to last season's Alamo Bowl, Thompson has led the Longhorns to points on 16 of his 18 possessions. He played mostly in mop-up duty in the first two games behind Hudson Card. "There's something about him when he gets in the game, the ball moves down field," Sarkisian said of Thompson. "I imagine Casey will lead the charge next week against Texas Tech." The Red Raiders have looked good so far this season especially when you consider their rush defense is allowing just 55 ypg. Yes, you read that right... a Texas Tech defense allowing just 21 ppg and 291 ypg. Still, this line is cheap for Texas right now.

**MEMPHIS 34 Utsa 31.** An inside-out handicap here. One one hand, you have a Memphis team off a misleading win over Mississippi St. The Bulldogs had 26-12 first down and 468-246 yard edges. Memphis got a 49-yard fumble return TD and a 94-yard punt return TD. The punt return was questionable to say the least. On the other side, UTSA dominated Middle Tennessee more than the final last week with 23-11 first down and 452-199 yard edges including 175-8 on the ground. MT scored 2 TD's in the final 3:28 getting 123 of their yards on those two drives. The problem is all of this is priced into this line with Memphis only a 3-point favorite. Pass.

**2★ TCU 38 Smu 25.** The 100th meeting of the Iron Skillet. TCU actually lost outright to SMU 41-38 the last time they played back in 2019. The Horned Frogs come in off a bye after a closer than expected win over Cal. They should be plenty motivated here. Meanwhile, SMU is very fortunate to be 3-0 getting a "Hail Mary" TD pass to beat Louisiana Tech last week. We like the Horned Frogs here to get revenge and we are surprised SMU is taking the early week money. We thought TCU was a good bet at -10!

**Iowa St 28 BAYLOR 20.** Sneaky good game here in the Big 12. Iowa St is really playing well on the defensive side of the ball allowing just 49 rush ypg and 193 total ypg. If not for those 4 offensive TO's vs Iowa, the Cyclones wouldn't be labeled "overrated" in the markets. On the other side, we think Baylor is underrated. The Bears are 3-0 outscoring their opponents by 36 ppg and re +331 ypg. They are taking a big step up class here though. We bet OVER 43.5 despite the fact Iowa St games are 3-0 to the UNDER this season. The early week money has agreed with us.

**FLORIDA 38 Tennessee 20.** We could not have been more impressed with a team in a loss than Florida last week. They dominated Alabama in the final three quarters of that game after trailing 21-3. There was nothing fluky as Florida won the box score with a 440-331 yard edge including 245-91 on the ground. The Gators now are averaging a 340-93 rushing edge per game this season. This is a really good team but how much effort was put into that game a week ago? Tennessee is also doing okay at the line of scrimmage with a 223-54 rushing yard edge per game (albeit vs a weak schedule so far). We took Tennessee +21.5 on the openers but like our UNDER 67.5 bet even better.

**3★ Clemson 30 NC STATE 16.** The Clemson offense has really struggled so far this season averaging just 8.5 ppg and 232 ypg vs Georgia and Georgia Tech. It's the main reason they are 0-3 ATS (-11.8 ppg). Last week as 4-TD favorites they needed a late stop on defense to prevent the game going to OT. However, the Tigers defense still hasn't allowed a TD this season. "The name of this game is points," Swinney said. "And when the other team can't score, you're going to win a lot of games." NC State is 2-1 but both their wins came vs weak competition. When they had to step up, they lost at Mississippi St. We bet Clemson -12 on the openers which was a terrible bet in hindsight giving the market has moved the other direction. Still, we like them here and think this is a "Buy Low" spot and remember NC State is down 2 defensive starters including their top player LB Wilson. The Westgate SuperBook had Clemson favored by 19 in the summer!

**MICHIGAN ST 28 Nebraska 24.** Obviously, Michigan St has been one of the biggest surprises of the season so far at 3-0 and last week went into Miami and crushed the Hurricanes 38-17 as 7-point underdogs. MSU only had a 454-440 yard edge but were +2 in TO's and out-rushed Miami 193-52. The Spartans outscored Miami 21-3 in the fourth quarter to pull away, somehow looking like the fresher, fitter team on a day where the on-field temperature hovered near 100 degrees. Meanwhile, the Huskers have covered 3 straight games since getting upset in the opener at Illinois. Last week, they nearly upset former long-time rival Oklahoma. How does MSU handle expectations now? We thought this line was fair and didn't bet it.

**MICHIGAN 35 Rutgers 17.** The top two teams in the country in ATS margin this season face off here. Both are 3-0 ATS with Michigan +19.0 ppg and Rutgers +17.8 ppg. Michigan has played like a top 10 team so far as they are averaging 350 rushing ypg this season and have blown out every foe. Last week, they scored touchdowns on their first nine drives, eight of them on the ground. The Wolverines never punted. Rutgers is outscoring their opponents on average 41-11 and have only allowed 260 ypg so far. We think this line is a bit steep and we lean with Rutgers.

**Troy 35 UL-MONROE 13.** Kudos for ULM breaking their 12-game losing streak dating back to 2019 last week. The problem is Jackson St is a below average FCS team and ULM was outgained 285-250. The Warhawks are averaging just 169 total ypg so far and won't find much success here vs a Troy defense allowing just 228 ypg and last week held Southern Miss to MINUS-1 yard rushing. We bet UNDER 56.5 on the openers but still lean that way at the current numbers.

**AUBURN 41 Georgia St 16.** Despite cashing a play on these pages against Auburn last week, we came away impressed with how they handled the "White Out" environment. Auburn had a 182-84 rushing yard edge but were stopped on 4th&Goal with 3:08 left. The defense is allowing just 46 rush ypg so far. Meanwhile, Georgia St got their first win and cover last week over Charlotte. Pro money came in on them all week. Auburn does have LSU on deck so this is a clear flat spot for them. Still, we don't see much value here. Pass.

**TULSA 38 Arkansas St 24.** Tulsa is 0-3 on the season but still isn't that far down in our power ratings from last year's team that almost won the AAC. Last week, Tulsa QB Davis Brin was 31 of 54 for 428 yards and 2 TD's and Ohio St only had a 508-501 yard edge vs them. This feels like a "get right" game for them much like it was for Arkansas St's opponent (Washington) last week. The Red Wolves were crushed 52-3 in Seattle failing to cover the spread by 31.5-points. This is another one where we don't see a ton of value. Pass.

**Buffalo 34 OLD DOMINION 20.** We were really down on Buffalo post-spring as they lost their coaching staff and 10 players from their 2-deep transferred out. The Bulls have actually played better than expected at 2-1 ATS and last week hung in tough as 2-TD underdogs to a ranked Coastal Carolina team (lost 28-25). Meanwhile, Old Dominion has also played better than expected this season at 2-1 ATS with their only non-cover coming by a 0.5-point last week at Liberty. The Monarchs have a new head coach and didn't play at all in 2019 but are +27 ypg. This is another game where we thought the number was pretty fair.

**LOUISIANA TECH 38 North Texas 27.** How does Louisiana Tech respond after being dealt their 2nd last-second loss of the season already? The Bulldogs had another upset brewing but SMU got a 33-yard Hail Mary TD pass on the final play for the win. The defense does have to improve after allowing 536 ypg so far. North Texas also played SMU this season and lost 35-12. Last week the Mean Green were crushed at home to UAB 40-6. NT QB's Aune and Rudder combined to go just 14 of 34 for 99 yards and a 1-1 ratio. We're not sure they can keep up here with Louisiana Tech but after playing 3 straight "to-the-wire" games, does LT have an "A" effort here? We bet OVER 60.5 early in the week.

**3★ New Mexico 28 UTEP 25.** We think this is a "Buy Low" spot for New Mexico. Last week one of our biggest power ratings' disparities was actually against them in their 34-0 loss at A&M. We feel a lot of people were on the Lobos in the market place and are throwing them in the trash as they are 0-3 ATS this season. We think that is a mistake. New Mexico is only allowing 85 rush ypg on the season and will give UTEP's rush-heavy offense fits. This week our ratings are pro-New Mexico and we bet them heavy on the openers. Wrong team favored!

**WASHINGTON 29 California 20.** Was last week the turning point for Washington and their offense? Embattled offensive coordinator John Donovan called the offense from the press box rather than on the field as he had last year and through the first two games this season. The Huskies have had issues with California as of late including losing outright as double-digit favorites in 2018 and 2019 (didn't play last year). However, we haven't been impressed with Cal so far including last week's 42-30 non-cover vs Sacramento St. We lean with the Huskies and the OVER here.

**OREGON 44 Arizona 14.** Arizona has now lost 15 straight games. Last week the losing streak was supposed to come to an end. The Wildcats were 26.5-point favorites over FCS Northern Arizona. Arizona led 13-0 late 2Q and then an interception return TD changed momentum and the Wildcats fell 21-19. "It's embarrassing," said Arizona's Stanley Berryhill III, who had 11 catches for 94 yards. "You don't want to lose to what you'd consider your little brother." The losing streak will continue here vs a Oregon team fresh off an easy win over FCS Stony Brook. Keep an eye on the Oregon QB's as starting QB Anthony Brown looked shaken up and true freshman Ty Thompson, who many thought would eventually become the starter played well in the second half. We're not involved here other than a pizza bet on Oregon at -27.5.

**† Texas A&M 27 Arkansas 20.** Played at AT&T Stadium in Arlington, TX. Since joining the SEC in 2012, Texas A&M is 9-0 SU vs Arkansas but 5 of those wins have come by 7 points or less and they are on a 0-3 ATS vs the Hogs. Last week, we felt the market downgraded the Aggies too much for the loss of QB Haynes King. A&M covered the big spread vs New Mexico 34-0 (-30). Still head coach Jimbo Fisher wasn't happy. "We're playing very average," Fisher said. Meanwhile, Arkansas has been better than average at 3-0 straight up and 3-0 ATS with an average cover by 12.8 ppg. The Hogs, in a flat spot, crushed Georgia Southern last week. This will be the toughest test for their offense though as we feel A&M has a Top 5 defense in the country. We like comparing lines this time of year. Two weeks ago, Texas was a 6-point favorite at Arkansas. Yes, Arkansas easily won and covered. Still, A&M is a better team than Texas and the Aggies are laying less at a neutral site. That says you're paying a premium on Arkansas now.

## Week 4 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past five seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 373-302-12 (55%) including an outstanding 71-50 (59%) last year! Last week's plays went 7-2 and are 17-9 on the season.** That's still pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 13 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **New Mexico +1**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

### HOME TEAM IN CAPS

#### Thursday, September 23rd

**Carolina 25 HOUSTON 17.** Obviously, the big story here is that QB Tyrod Taylor has been placed on IR and Davis Mills will make his first career start for the Texans. Mills was 8 of 18 for 102 yards (1-1 ratio) last week in relief. On the other side, we easily cashed with Carolina last week as our top play as they crushed the Saints as home dogs. However, now at 2-0 they're playing with expectations and we'll see how they handle it. The Texans were probably under-valued this season as they are 2-0 ATS but that was with Taylor under center. We like Carolina in a teaser here (tied with Buffalo or Minnesota).

#### Sunday, September 26th

**Arizona 28 JACKSONVILLE 21.** 2-0 vs 0-2 usually screams value on the 0-2 team in the NFL especially if they are in the home dog role. However, we're not running to the window to bet Jacksonville here. There's a big difference between CFB and the NFL and there's no better examples than these head coaches. Meyer, the ultra successful CFB coach, probably won't last long while Kingsbury, the failed college coach, is doing a solid job. We did cash fading Arizona last week as they were fortunate to beat Minnesota. This isn't a great spot for the Cards though with the Rams on deck. However, if Jacksonville's defense looked feeble against Tyrod Taylor and Teddy Bridgewater, what are they going to do vs a more dynamic Kyler Murray?

**TENNESSEE 25 Indianapolis 21.** Last week the Titans scored the game's final 17 points to steal a win in Seattle. Meanwhile, the Colts offensive line woes continued last week as they allowed 6 sacks and QB Carson Wentz was KO'd. As of press-time, we're not sure if he will get the start here. If he doesn't go it will be Jacob Eason for Indy. We wanted to back the desperate 0-2 division dog but the UNDER is probably the best play.

**Baltimore 28 DETROIT 20.** How much does Baltimore have in the tank here? They have played two wire-to-wire games in prime-time vs the Raiders and Chiefs. They did outscore KC 12-0 in that final quarter to avoid the 0-2 start and kudos to head coach Harbaugh for being aggressive and going for it on 4th Down to end the game (analytic nerds rejoice!). The Lions come in on the short week off the 35-17 loss to Green Bay as they were outscored 21-0 in the second half. They have played hard for one half in each of their first two games but will need to play a full 60 minutes to stay under this number. We lean Ravens but prefer them in a teaser.

**BUFFALO 26 Washington 18.** Obviously, the Bills got right last week in a dominating win over the Dolphins to avoid an 0-2 start. Meanwhile the Football Team has extra rest after a fortunate win over the Giants last Thursday. Buffalo's defense has allowed just one TD through the first two games. That's not good news for Washington and backup Heinicke. Again, we're not wild about laying more than a TD in the NFL so we like teasing Buffalo down through key numbers of "7 and 3".

**NEW ENGLAND 23 New Orleans 19.** Will the real New Orleans and Jameis Winston please stand up? After the dominating win over Green Bay in Week 1, we faded the Saints last week and they were crushed by Carolina. The 128 yards of offense was the fewest by the Saints in 20 years! Keep in mind, they were short-staffed and also short-handed due to COVID and injuries. Meanwhile, turnovers crushed the Pats in Week 1 but they picked off rookie QB Wilson 4 times last week in a easy win over the Jets. This is the 3rd straight road game for the Saints.

**KANSAS CITY 30 L.A. Chargers 24.** The Kansas City Chiefs have covered one time in their last 13 games! We repeat, the Chiefs are on a 1-11-1 ATS run dating back to last year. However, you don't pay a premium fading them because they are a public team with Reid and Mahomes and they still find ways to win straight up (10-3 SU in that stretch). Last week they got out-scored 12-0 in the final quarter and a fumbled exchange prevented them from winning late. The Chargers have played in 25 one-possession games since 2019 (league-high) including last week's close loss to Dallas. We expect more of the same.

**N.Y. GIANTS 24 Atlanta 23.** Two desperate 0-2 teams here. Last week Atlanta QB Ryan tossed 3 interceptions and two of them were

returned for TD's. Meanwhile, the Giants have extra rest after blowing the game late vs Washington. The G-Men have now lost more games than anyone in the NFL the last 5 years. While we originate in CFB, we lean on a team of bettors and handicappers in the NFL that specialize specifically in the sport. All of them take different approaches and all of them like the Falcons here.

**CLEVELAND 25 Chicago 18.** Justin Fields could be making his first start here with Andy Dalton banged up. Fields didn't look that great (6 of 12 for 60 yards and an INT). It was the Bears D that forced 4 TO's last week that were critical in their win over the Bengals. Chicago will have trouble protecting either Dalton or Fields against Myles Garrett and Company. We're not wild about either side so we will lean with the UNDER here.

**PITTSBURGH 22 Cincinnati 19.** We backed the Steelers on these pages last week and we're not sure we will be backing them again anytime soon. Despite a huge situational edge catching the Raiders on a short week traveling off a big win, Pittsburgh was thoroughly outplayed. This should be the final season for Big Ben and he may not even start here behind a terrible offensive line. The up-start Bengals nearly started 2-0 but were done in by TO's in Chicago last week. Lean UNDER if you have to get involved.

**LAS VEGAS 23 Miami 21.** Kudos to the Raiders for getting us on these pages last week in their upset over the Steelers. We were more impressed with that performance than the win over the Ravens on MNF. Now this is the type of game where Gruden and Company have struggled with lately. Playing with expectations. They're taking on a wounded Miami team fresh off a 35-0 loss to the Bills and as of press-time we're not sure if Tua will play here. We lean Dolphins.

**DENVER 26 N.Y. Jets 16.** 2-0 vs 0-2 usually has us taking the 0-2 team that no one wants to bet on. However, the Jets are an absolute mess especially on offense. Who knew that the under-sized kid that feasted upon nothing but Group of 5 teams in CFB would be overwhelmed in his rookie year? But wow, Wilson sure looked great during his pro day. Now he's playing behind a depleted offensive line and opposing defenses smell blood in the water. That will be the case again here. How do you fade Teddy Bridgewater and his 38-14 ATS mark as a starting QB? However, he's never been this big of a favorite before.

**3★ OVER 55 Tampa Bay 31 L.A. RAMS 30.** Obviously the game of the weekend and a potential NFC Championship game. All the money has come in on Tampa Bay here with the line flipping them to favorite. The ageless Tom Brady threw 5 TD passes last week and the defense got two "Pick 6's" to seal it. Tampa has now scored 30 or more points in 9 straight games (NFL record) and they have won 10 straight games. Meanwhile, the Rams got a 3-point win (didn't cover) at Indy last week and this is the type of game where the move to Stafford at QB could pay off. We're taking the OVER. No weather concerns, fast track. Both Tampa games have flown OVER.

**2★ MINNESOTA 29 Seattle 27.** It's really tough imagining a 0-3 start for the Vikings. They have two heart-breaking losses to start the season but we did cash with them last week as they were getting 3.5-4 points in Arizona (Minn missed the game-winning FG on the final play). We would have preferred Seattle to come in a fat-and-happy 2-0 but they blew their big lead at home to Tennessee last week. We like Minnesota here and really like them in a teaser up through 3 and 7.

**2★ Green Bay 27 SAN FRANCISCO 26.** The 49ers come in off back-to-back road wins but they are banged up especially at RB.
