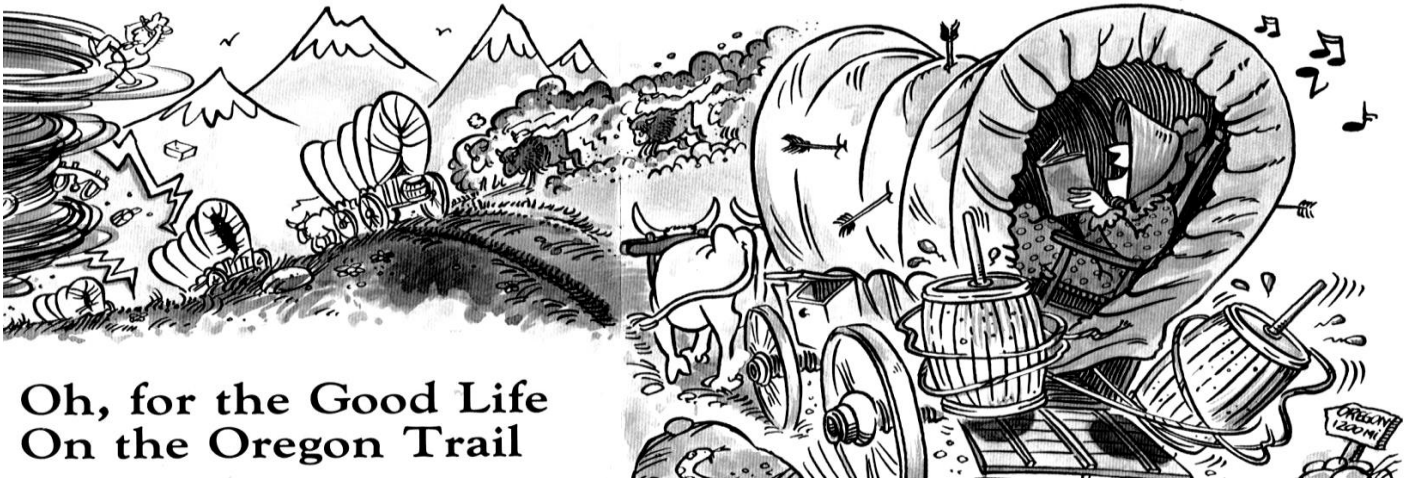


Oregon Trail Days 2023
